A Reflection on Luke 11:1-13 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

After teaching "the Lord's Prayer," Jesus teaches his disciples how to persist in prayer and trust in God's goodness. He gives the story of a man who knocks on his friend's door at midnight, asking for bread to feed a friend of his. The friend initially refuses but eventually gives in because of his persistence.

Reflecting on our prayers and petitions, we should ask ourselves: Are we persistent in prayer, or do we give up too quickly when answers do not come? We should learn that our prayers and our petitions are always answered but may differ from our requests. Sometimes, the answer is "yes," but it


