A Note From Our Pastor V. Rev. Daniel Greenleaf

Dear Parishioners,

Because of Labor Day, I needed to write this column the day after the news of the shooting at the Catholic school while students were at Church praying. I have to confess that as I was watching it, my eyes started to flood with tears. I am sure that some of it has to do with the memories of our own tragic experience in Lewiston, and some it has to do with the image of beautiful Catholic children praying and the horror of experiencing such evil. These experiences cause me, and I am sure all of us, to question how we do things here to protect everyone. Let us keep the parish and school in our prayers.

Now that summer is over, it is time to be about the business of parish life and pastoral care. Faith formation and parish groups are all starting up and it becomes a great time to discern how you might want to get involved in the parish this year. I am amazed at how a commitment to some aspect of parish life usually helps in growing in faith and love for God. I know that there are a lot of changes, and that people are trying to find their way in this new structure as a parish. Know that I want to make myself available if needed to discuss where you might fit into different parish groups.

Scott and the music program at the Basilica are offering an amazing concert this month. Our Catholic faith has a rich patrimony of music that will last generations, and it is amazing how so many of us are not familiar with much of it. On Sunday, September 28th at 2:30 PM, please come to the Basilica and hear two Mass settings, one from Schubert and one from Vierne. Vierne's "Messe Solennelle." Scott is excited about presenting the Vierne's work because it fits beautifully at the Basilica's two organs. Along with the Choral Art, Catholics will recognize the parts of the Holy Mass as one organist will be up front and one will be in the balcony. During this month, we will be offering more educational videos and texts to help the parish grow in appreciation of our musical heritage.

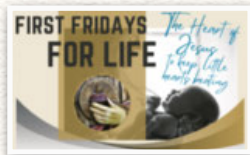

NOTICE: Low Gluten Hosts

Effective September 1, our parish will follow the new diocesan policy regarding the distribution of low-gluten hosts at Mass:

- **Low-gluten hosts (not gluten-free)** will now be supplied by the parish. Communicants may no longer bring their own.
- Those needing a low-gluten host should **check in at the sacristy before Mass**. The host will be placed in a pyx and brought to the altar for consecration.
- During Communion, the minister will hand the pyx to the communicant and say, "*The Body of Christ.*" The communicant will then open the pyx and receive the host.
- After Mass, the pyx must be returned to the sacristy for proper purification and storage.

If you or a family member regularly require a low-gluten host, please contact the parish office to arrange for ongoing accommodation in accord with diocesan norms.

For those who cannot walk with us, the procession will be live-streamed in the Church Hall at Holy Trinity so all may participate in asking for Our Lady's intercession.

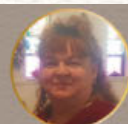
