A Note From Our Pastor V. Rev. Daniel Greenleaf

Dear Parishioners,

The Sacrament of the Sick is one of the healing Sacraments in our faith, and the hospital is the primary place Catholics have received this grace. For years, the Catholic Appeal has supported Catholic ministry at our hospitals, and though the priests were not employees of the hospitals, they did enjoy a status of being a team member in the chaplain's office. We have now learned that Central Maine Medical Center laid off their entire pastoral care department and eliminated the ministry. Fr. Gabriel, our Catholic chaplain, is no longer afforded the accommodations that have always been given as a Catholic priest. Therefore, it is very important that if you or your loved one need a priest for the Sacrament of the Sick, you will have to call the parish line, and we will forward the call to Fr. Gabriel or Fr. Peter. The priests have left their number at the different places in the hospital, but we have learned that staff have told patients that there is no longer a pastoral care office available. This is one more effort to remove God and faith from our public sphere. Please know that if you are in the hospital and want the Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion, you will have to call us. Maybe it will change in the future, but for now, the burden falls on you or your loved one.

October is upon us, and it is the month of the Rosary. Next week, we will invite parishioners to join the priests after Mass as they process to the Blessed Mother statue to pray one decade of the Rosary. We invite especially families with little children to join us for the

prayer. It will include a small expression using candles to involve the youngest among us to expose them to the prayers. I learned from my Family and Faith Commission that we cannot assume that everyone knows how to pray the Rosary, so we will be passing out material all month on the Rosary to help encourage people to make it a standard part of their spirituality. Please bring your children and grandchildren to the Blessed Mother statue for the month to honor the month of the Rosary. Next week, we will have the Rosary procession, which is another family event. Join us as we walk the downtown streets of Lisbon Falls praying the Rosary.

Finally, I would like to draw your attention to the Liturgy of the Word for Children that will begin at the 8:30 a.m. Sunday Mass at Holy Family. We already host it at Holy Trinity and the Basilica as a way to expose children to God's Holy Word. For those who do not know, it is a time for children to hear the same readings proclaimed in the Church, but using the translation for children put out by the Bishop's Conference. simpler approach helps the children take God's Word into their hearts and hopefully remain there to form them. Know that if your children are afraid to go, you are always free to go with them until they are comfortable. Also, please remember that we have the Magnifikid at the entrances of the Church. Please go through it with your children to help them appreciate the We really are trying to help parents and grandparents to form their (grand)children in the faith. More to come! Peace, Fr. Daniel

DECREE

ESTABLISHING AN ORATORY/CHAPEL AT HOLY FAMILY CHURCH, LEWISTON

In Nomine Domini

In accord with canons 1223, 1224, 1225, and 1229, I, Most Reverend James T. Ruggieri, Bishop of Portland, hereby decree and grant permission for the establishment of an oratory/chapel at Holy Family Church, 607 Sabattus Street, Lewiston, Maine, located in the basement of the church office. This oratory/chapel is designated for the benefit of the parishioners of Prince of Peace Parish, Lewiston, Sabattus, and Lisbon Falls.

Ordinarily, this oratory/chapel will be used for Eucharistic Adoration and the celebration of the Eucharist. Other Sacraments are not to be celebrated here, except by way of exception and in case of necessity, as determined by the Pastor of Prince of Peace Parish.

The Holy Eucharist may be reserved in this oratory/chapel. There must always be someone responsible for the Holy Eucharist.

Insofar as possible, a priest is to celebrate Mass at this oratory/chapel at least twice a month in accord with the provisions of canon 934. In addition, canon 938 requires that the tabernacle in which the Most Holy Eucharist is reserved must be situated in some part of the oratory/chapel which is distinguished, conspicuous, beautifully decorated, and suitable for prayer (c. 938 §2). The tabernacle is to be immovable, made of solid and opaque material, and locked in such a way that the danger of profanation is avoided as much as possible (c. 938 §3). The person responsible for the oratory/chapel is to take care that the key to the tabernacle in which the Most Holy Eucharist is reserved is safeguarded most diligently (c. 938 §5). Finally, a special lamp which indicates and honors the presence of Christ is to shine continuously before the tabernacle (c. 940).

One copy of this decree is to be kept at the Chancery of the Diocese of Portland, and one copy should be kept at Prince of Peace Parish, Lewiston, Maine.



Icon Prayer Service

On Wednesday, October 1st at 6 PM at Holy Trinity Church the Knights of Columbus Councils of the Prince of Peace Parish are hosting a Sacred Heart Holy Hour featuring an icon depicting the most famous image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, painted in 1767 by Pompeo Batoni and now venerated in the Church of the Gesù in Rome. The reproduction bears the blessing of Pope Francis, through the Papal Almoner, and is one of more than 300 icons traveling across the world, from council to council, for veneration and use in prayer services.

The Sacred Heart Holy Hour includes readings from Sacred Scripture and reflections from Pope Francis on the Sacred Heart, as well as the Divine Mercy Chaplet, prayers to the Sacred Heart and time for silent prayer.

Note: This Prayer Service is taking place instead of the previously scheduled Rosary.




