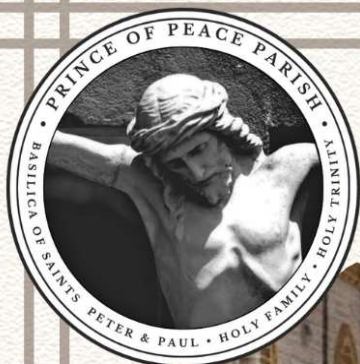
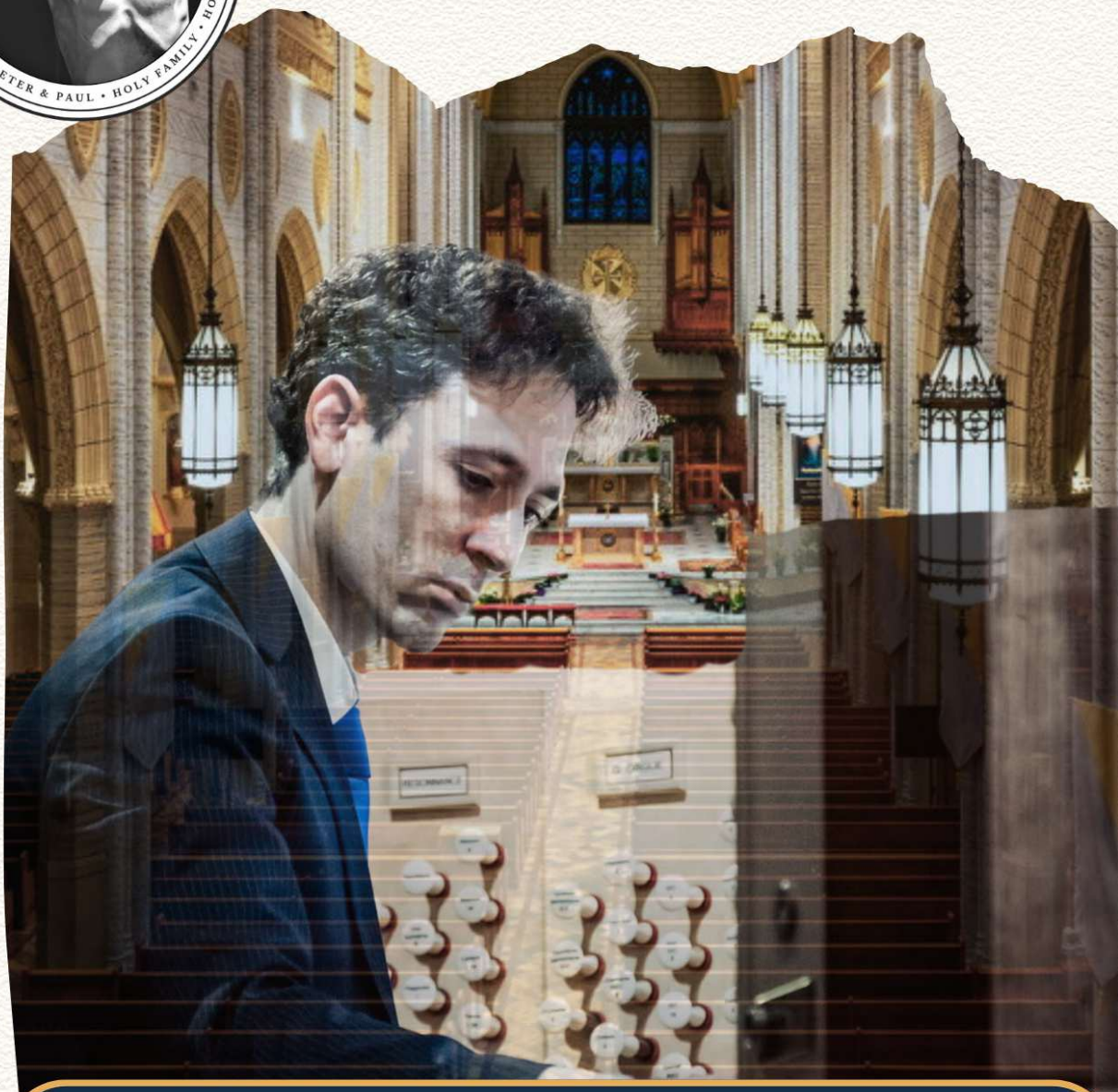

Dear Parishioners,

We are very fortunate to have a robust music program at Prince of Peace Parish. There are choirs for all ages and styles of liturgical music. We are offering another session of "Making Music, Praying Twice" for parents with children from the ages of three months to grade school. It is a great way to expose children to music from our faith at a very early age, since we believe it is never too young to appreciate the gift of music. I do recognize that it is after the 8:30 AM Mass on Thursday at Holy Trinity, and that it makes it possible only for those parents who are home with their children during the day. I would like to offer another session for parents who work during the week if there were a need. Please let me know if there is any interest in another time. Along with infants and toddlers, Pauline Sabo is offering a music program for older children at the same time at Holy Trinity. This becomes a wonderful opportunity for homeschoolers to come to Mass and stay behind for our music program. This will complement the Sunday morning music program Pauline does at the Basilica. It is my hope that these early experiences will stay with Catholics their whole life and nurture their faith in Christ. If you are an adult and would like to sing, we have programs for that as well. Just contact us, and we can discuss where your interests are.

Plans are coming together for a very busy November. Not only do we remember the people who have celebrated a funeral Mass here in the parish, but we will be having the Memorial Book to list all our loved ones who have passed away. November also includes our yearly veterans roll in the bulletin and our Thanksgiving Masses and food drive. This all happens while we are preparing for Advent. It is so hard to believe that these things are all around the corner. Please pay close attention to the bulletin for more details as they are announced.

This year's group of OCIA members is forming, but there is still time to prepare to become Catholic this coming Easter. If you know someone who is interested in becoming Catholic, it is not too late to encourage them. Bringing the topic up is one way you might be responding to the Spirit working by being his helper as he draws people closer to Christ. All too often, people are waiting to be invited, and when they are, they consider that the sign they needed to take the next step. October is the Month of the Rosary

How the Blessed Mother always leads us to Jesus.

Last week we reflected on how we can enter into the mysteries of the Rosary — like one family who prayed through the Joyful Mysteries as they welcomed a new child into their home. In keeping with that theme, when we pray to Mary — especially the words, “*pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death*” — do we truly understand what we are asking?

It may sound unusual to say that I love the film *The Passion of the Christ*, but I am deeply moved by Mel Gibson’s portrayal of Mary. She is always present, following Jesus along the *Via Dolorosa* — the Way of the Cross. It is her steadfast faithfulness at the heart of our salvation, her heart pierced by sorrow, that pours forth such mercy for us in the name of Christ.

One scene stands out. As Jesus falls under the weight of the Cross, Mary flashes back to a moment from His childhood when He scraped His knee. That tender, relentless love of a mother — an ever-burning lantern calling her child home to rest and be fed — is the same love that still watches over us.

When we ask her to pray for us, now and at the hour of our death, we acknowledge that our sin — made manifest in the nails, the thorns, and the weight of the Cross — was laid bare on Good Friday. Mary, the ever-vigilant Mother, bore witness to it all and yet remained. By the Cross she stood and was entrusted to the world as a sign of true hope. In her perfect obedience, forgiveness, and expectant hope in the Resurrection, she shows us what we are truly asking: how to suffer with love, in the name of Jesus — not for the sake of this world, but for the joy of the next.

In our home hangs a painting of *L’Innocence* by William-Adolphe Bouguereau. It depicts a barefoot Mary holding a sleeping infant in one arm and a vigilant lamb in the other. I see in it the love my wife has for our children — a love that watches like the lamb and trusts like the child. That is the love we ask Mary to lead us into when we pray: a love that stays, that trusts, and that draws us ever closer to the heart of God, even at the hour of our death.

Dwell: Finding Sanctuary Within A Jubilee Retreat for High School Teens Where do you find rest?

In a world full of noise, distraction, and pressure, teens need a place to breathe — a space to encounter the living God and hear His voice.
