A Note From Our Pastor V. Rev. Daniel Greenleaf


Dear Parishioners,

November has begun, and it is the month when Catholics remember those who have passed away. To remember the dead, to pray for them, and to ask for their intercession are activities that Catholics have done for centuries as spiritual works of mercy. We will have the annual book of the dead at each church for you to place the names of your loved ones. For each Mass for the month of November, we will have an intention for all the names listed in the book. Feel free to look for the purple banner with a binder and book. We have invited the families of those whose loved ones have celebrated funerals in our churches this past year to Masses on the weekend of November 16, and we will read their names and toll a bell in prayer for their souls. Along with these activities, we will remember Veterans, and various groups will host prayer services in honor of the deceased. It is what we do as Catholics for this month.

We are closing on the lease with Community Concepts, who plans on moving into the Holy Family School building. They plan on doing some updating to the building as part of their lease. The basement floor will be for the parish. We are planning on making the basement our parish evangelization center along with a small Catholic shop. Our evangelization center will be a place of education and faith sharing for groups, which will give us more spaces to meet in this very busy parish. As soon as it is ready, we will host an open house.

We are also closing on the sale of property the parish owns on Martin Drive in Lewiston. The city is interested in the property and plans on keeping it a park and little league field. This was our hope and the reason why we opted to turn to the city to purchase and care for the property. There are rumors and much confusion in the media and among interested parties, but not one of them has ever spoken to me to get information that is firsthand. I am hoping we can close on this property soon, and it can remain a place for families to gather and create memories.




