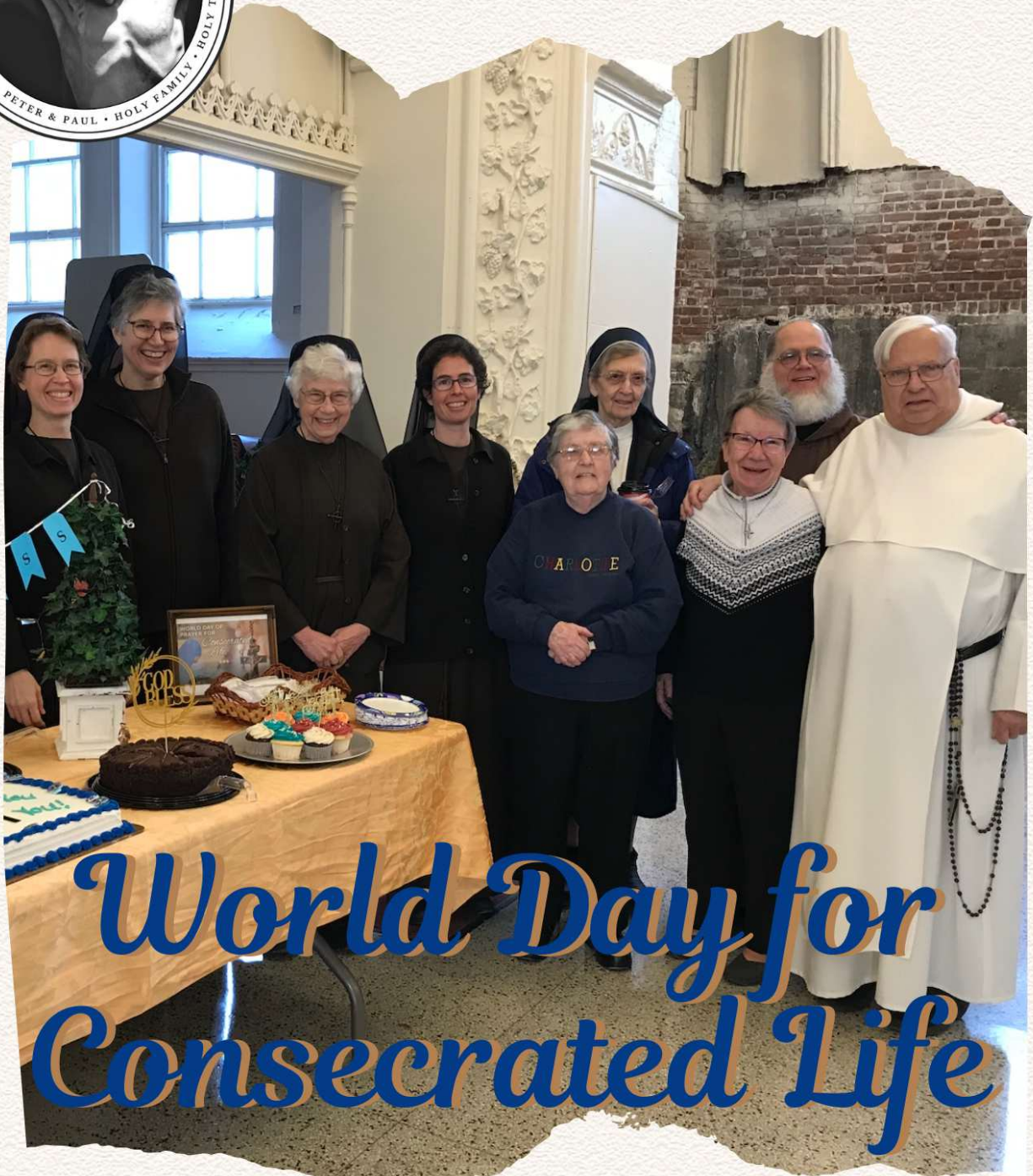

A Note From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we are celebrating Consecrated Life in our Church as we recognize all the religious men and women who have given their lives in service to Christ. Each year, on February 2nd, the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, the Church remembers those who have taken vows of singular heart to God as their calling in life. We are so enriched by the faith and devotion of our religious. They stand in our midst as a witness to what we are all called to live because of our baptismal vows. I remember hearing that what we are all called to live, God calls people in a special and more intense way as a reminder. We must continue to pray for more men and women to answer the call to consecrated life for the health and depth of the Church.

Another sign in our midst are sacramentals. This weekend, we will bless throats through the intercession of St. Blaise. This will take place after each of the Masses this weekend since his feast day is Tuesday, February 3. The use of crossed candles placed at the throat commemorates when St. Blaise healed a boy choking on a fishbone. He was martyred by iron combs and then beheaded for refusing to renounce his Christian faith. I am always touched by so many in the Church who gave their life and never renounced their faith even after being tortured. Today, it does not take much before we give up.

This weekend I start celebrating the Mass according to the 1962 Missal, known as the Latin or Tridentine Mass. The Bishop asked that the parish take over responsibility of the Mass, which is celebrated at 8:30 at the Basilica. You will start seeing references to the 1962 Missal in this bulletin to designate that Mass. The challenge for us is that this Mass is also on the old liturgical calendar. This Sunday is Septuagesima, which marks the beginning of pre-Lent. Today marks the start of pre-Lent and it goes for 17 days until Ash Wednesday. It is my hope that both liturgies, the 1962 Missal and the 2002 Missal will enrich each other. For now, I am just trying to get through learning how to celebrate this Mass. Fr. Michael, Fr. Gabriel and Fr. Peter all also going to be in the mix as celebrants. There is more to come. Peace, Fr. Daniel
