## A Note From Our Pastor V. Rev. Daniel Greenleaf

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend starts the immediate preparation for the elect to enter into the Church at the Easter Vigil. At various Masses, we will be celebrating the Scrutinies. After the homily, the unbaptized will come to the front of the Church to receive the minor rites of exorcism, intercession and grace to find the strength in their resolve to follow Christ. The reading this weekend is the woman at the well and it is one of my favorites because the woman encounters Jesus and she is changed. She runs to the townspeople, and they come out to see him. Their words should be on the lips of each and every Catholic, "We no longer believe because of your word; for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is truly the savior of the world." First the people believed because of her word; they came out to listen to his word; and it says that many more believe because of (Jesus's) word. We all hear about Jesus from others, but each person is called to make the decisive act of belief in Jesus because he or she has come to see for himself or herself. May that be the great Easter gift to each of us.

I always have one paragraph on the various construction projects going on. I am so happy to report to the parish that the work on the bathrooms in the narthex of Holy Family has begun. This long-awaited work will now happen. Unfortunately, there will be some disruption during Holy Week and the Easter season, but it is really unavoidable. As I write this, we are now in conflict with the Middle East. I am sure that there are various opinions in the parish. I would hope that everyone is praying for a quick resolution to the war. # Let Us Begin Again

Have you ever taken a trip and found yourself pausing along the way? As we enter our third week of Lent, with the destination of Easter Sunday in mind, we may find ourselves traveling down roads we didn't intend. Yet for the mindful, these delays become moments of mercy in a penitential season.

Recently, my wife and I took our children on a trip out of state. Notice I didn't call it a vacation – it was a trip, and in my mind I was there to conquer all that there was to do and see. Inevitably, my plan required a lot of traveling from site to site, ping-ponging on public transportation. I wanted my family to get the whole experience. Sometimes I think our Lent can go like that. For the ambitious, we try to *do* Lent right.

I imagine for the disciples following Jesus there was an air of excitement and mystery. Yet Jesus pauses at Jacob's well and meets the Samaritan woman. There He opens for her not the path to the Temple Mount but the road to Calvary.

While we had a wonderful time, and I certainly tried to free my family from the worry of the clock, it was when we found ourselves delayed on a bus, trying to get back to our rooms for a reset before the next leg of the trip, that I encountered a man suffering with nerve damage and cancer, offering a brief glimpse of what it means to suffer with joy. Hearing his story of sacrifice for his family, of prayers offered, and of holding close to the simplicity of St. Francis, I was reminded: it is good to pause and listen.

You never know who you will meet down by the well.

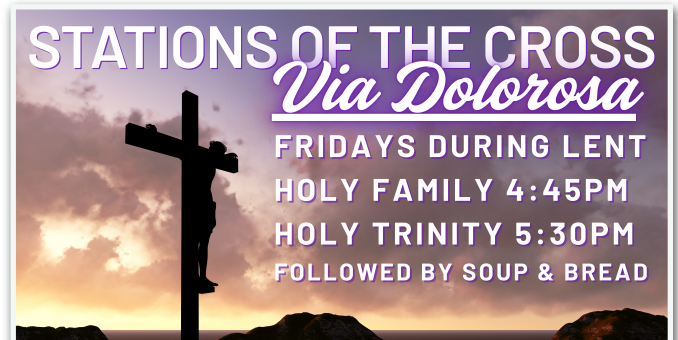

## Friday Lenten Indulgence

On the Fridays of Lent, the faithful may obtain a plenary indulgence by devoutly praying the **Prayer Before a Crucifix** after receiving Holy Communion.

Under the usual conditions (Confession, Holy Communion, prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father, and detachment from sin), this indulgence may be applied to oneself or to the souls in Purgatory.

## Prayer Before A Crucifix

Look down upon me, good and gentle Jesus, while before Your face I humbly kneel and, with burning soul, pray and beseech You to fix deep in my heart lively sentiments of faith, hope, and charity; true contrition for my sins, and a firm purpose of amendment. While I contemplate, with great love and tender pity, Your five most precious wounds, pondering over them within me and calling to mind the words which David, Your prophet, said to You, my Jesus: "They have pierced My hands and My feet, they have numbered all My bones." Amen.
