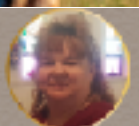
diocesan youth ministry throughout my school years. Through these experiences and the witness of faithful peers, my relationship with Christ grew, and I began to consider the possibility of a priestly vocation.

Through diocesan vocation retreats and my involvement with the Newman Center at the University of Maine, I grew in prayer, frequent reception of the sacraments, friendship with other faithful Catholics, and love for the Church. As my faith matured, I became convinced that I should enter seminary and pursue discernment of the diocesan priesthood more intentionally.

After graduating from the University of Maine in 2022, I entered seminary for the Diocese of Portland. Seminary has continued to challenge and form me, and I am grateful to the Lord for leading me here. I look forward with joy and trust to whatever He has in store for the future.
