



## POSITION SUMMARY

TOTUS TUUS (Totally Yours) is a parish-based summer catechetical program, for both grade school age children and junior/ senior high school youth. Totus Tuus Missionaries are trained and put onto teams of four, traveling to parishes across the Diocese, putting on week-long “parish missions” to teach and inspire the young.

## PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Communicate the Gospel and promote the Diocesan Vision and Mission to youth.
- Witness the Christian life to children and youth through catechesis and personal example.
- Committed to a well-defined daily schedule of prayer and activities, including set-up and clean-up before and after daily sessions, leading daily prayers for youth, preparing for Liturgies, catechetical instruction, and organizing daily community building activities.
- Actively participate in Missionary Training.
- Actively collaborate with parish leadership and volunteers.
- Travel to parishes throughout the Diocese of Davenport to lead week-long Totus Tuus sessions, staying with host families at each parish site.
- Actively promote a safe environment for children and youth, in accordance with Diocese of Davenport Safe Environment policies.

- Communicate well with leaders in parishes and families at host sites.
- Adequate knowledge of the Catholic faith and ability to communicate it to others.
- A desire to work with youth and children grades 1-12.
