"Mary set out and traveled to the hill country in haste..." (Luke 1:39) Mary had great news and she had been told by the angel Gabriel that Elizabeth had great news. In her joy, she traveled into the hill country in haste. The power of the most high had overshadowed Mary and "Elizabeth filled with the Holy Spirit cried out" in joy. Both women had been touched by the Holy Spirit we want to be with others who have had similar experiences. We are often
