Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is the greatest mystery of our Catholic Faith because it concerns God Himself. The Lord Jesus revealed to us that God is One God but Three Divine Persons. Concerning the Trinity, St. Athanasius

(373 A.D.) wrote:

"We acknowledge the Trinity, holy and perfect, to consist of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. In this Trinity there is no intrusion of any alien element or of anything from outside, nor is the Trinity a blend of creative and created being. It is a wholly creative and energizing reality, self-consistent and undivided in its active power, for the Father makes all things through the Word and in the Holy Spirit, and in this way the unity of the holy Trinity is preserved. Accordingly, in the Church, one God is preached, one God who is above all things and through all things and in all things. God is above all things as Father, for he is principle and source; he is through all things through the Word; and he is in all things in the Holy Spirit.

Writing to the Corinthians about spiritual atters, Paul traces all reality back to one God, the Father, saying: Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and varieties of service, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of working, but it is the same God who inspires them all in everyone.

Even the gifts that the Spirit dispenses to individuals are given by the Father through the Word. For all that belongs to the Father belongs also to the Son, and so the graces given by the Son in the Spirit are true gifts of the Father. Similarly, when the Spirit dwells in us, the Word who bestows the Spirit is in us too, and the Father is present in the Word. This is the meaning of the text: *My Father and I will come to him and make our home with him.* For where the light is, there also is the radiance; and where the radiance is, there too are its power and its resplendent grace.

This is also Paul's teaching in his second letter to the Corinthians: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. For grace and the gift of the Trinity are given by the Father through the Son in the Holy Spirit. Just as grace is given from the Father through the Son, so there could be no communication of the gift to us except in the Holy Spirit. But when we share in the Spirit, we possess the love of the Father, the grace of the Son and the fellowship of the Spirit himself."



EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION. Next Sunday, June 11, is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. This celebration is focused of the gift of Jesus present Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Eucharist. We will have a Eucharistic Procession around the neighborhood immediately following the 9:30am Mass.

SACRED HEART MASS & HEALING SERVICE. Friday, June 16, is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will have Mass at 6pm followed by a Healing Service. Eucharistic adoration, laying on of hands, the anointing of the sick and confession will be available. Seriously consider participating as we all need some form of healing whether spiritual, emotional or physical. Everyone is welcome.

Traditionally, the Catholic Church dedicates the month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. For Catholics, June is never "Pride" month nor is any other month. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (par. 2357) states: "Basing itself on Sacred Scripture, which presents homosexual acts as acts of grave depravity, tradition has always declared that 'homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered.' They are contrary to the natural law. They close the sexual act to the gift of life. They do not proceed from a genuine affective and sexual complementarity. Under no circumstances can they be approved." We need to pray for those who are struggling with or have given in to this area of sin.
