Christmas is always the time of great jubilation because Christ is born! "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us..." (Jn 1:). The Son of the Eternal Father, Who is the Eternal Word, has become man for you and I. God truly dwells with His people. He is

God truly dwells with His people, He is Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." Not only was He born two thousand years ago in human history, He remains with us in the flesh even to this very day. Jesus Christ is really present in the Eucharist and is born for us on the altar at every Mass. This is our cause of great rejoicing!

We are not alone! God has looked upon our misery and difficulties of life. He chose to be born into helplessness and abject poverty. Though He is great and without measure or limit, God became small for us. Jesus remains small for us in the Eucharist so His people would approach Him and not be afraid. Who can be afraid of a little baby? Who could be afraid of Jesus Who remains under the appearance of bread and wine?

He is wrapped in swaddling clothes and laid in a manger by His mother. The manger was a feeding trough for animals. Jesus would offer Himself 33 years later to His apostles, and then over time to us, as food for the soul in the Eucharist. But this gift of Himself could only be given through His death, which was indicated by the swaddling cloth – a prelude to the burial shroud that would cover His crucified and tortured body. This cloth would also indicate His resurrection, since it would be folded by Him and laid neatly in the tomb after He rose and was miraculously imprinted with His sacred image. The Church still has this cloth, which is known as the Shroud of Turin.

The joy of Christmas is the true joy of the soul. For the Christian, this joy is also touched by the reality of the Cross. Jesus was the only one who was born into this world to die. But His birth, death and resurrection bring us life. Of this supreme gift we are grateful and we offer our thanksgiving to the Eternal Father for it. The word Eucharist means *thanksgiving*. We offer to the Father His Son Jesus in the Eucharist at every Mass. Let us joyfully celebrate this Christ-Mass.

In honor of St. John, who was deep-fried in a pot of boiling oil (miraculously, it had no effect on him). The meal is free. 


