

OUR RETURN TO PUBLIC MASS CELEBRATION

Our Mass Schedule will be exactly the same as usual, but we will have to follow all of the special safety guidelines and precautions established by the Archdiocese of Atlanta and the CDC. Here is the list of these precautions:

- Everyone (adults and children) will be required to wear a face mask from the time they enter the church.
- Everyone will be required to use the supplied hand sanitizer upon entering the church.
- Social distancing will be maintained such that there is at least a 6-foot separation between all those attending Mass except members of the same household. The ushers will assist in the necessary spacing.
- The collection basket will not be passed. Instead, it will be placed in the narthex for everyone to drop their regular parish offering. Thus, there is no offertory procession.
- We will avoid shaking hands during the exchange of the sign of peace.
- Clergy and Eucharistic Ministers will use hand sanitizer before and after the distribution of Communion and wear a mask during the distribution.
- Communion will be received in the hands only, and the distribution of the Precious Blood will be discontinued.
- All common surfaces within the church (including pews, door handles, etc.) will be sanitized after each
- Hymnals/Missals will not be available at the church, because they cannot be sanitized. However, the text for the hymns, the Responsorial Psalm and the Parish Prayer will be presented on a large screen in the front of the church.

Please do not come to Mass if you have a fever or feel ill. We will still be recording and publishing our Sunday Masses. Archbishop Gregory J. Hartmayer has extended the dispensation from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass. If you do not feel safe coming to Mass at this time, please feel free to participate by watching our recorded Sunday Mass.
