TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

We have the wedding at Cana at the heart of today's liturgy because this story of Jesus' first miracle of water turned into wine was originally part of the Epiphany feast. Wedding celebrations always require some savvy planning, and a people who have a talent for hospitality in the mix. The mother of Jesus has been recruited to deal with some of the details of the banquet, and when a very understandable crisis arises, she does what she can to rescue the party. Anyone who has ever run out of ice, dessert, or table settings knows the stress!

Slowly, the memory of Jesus Christ's blessing of this marriage feast led the Church to form a way to bless marriages. A thousand years ago weddings migrated from the family home to the doors of the church, where the celebration was held in public view. From this practice came a prayer called the "Nuptial Blessing," one of the most solemn prayers in our tradition. It is very much like the prayers by which baptismal water and chrism are consecrated, the ordination prayer over a priest, and the Eucharistic Prayers over bread and wine. Four hundred fifty years ago, weddings moved inside the church building. All of this gives married couples good reason to celebrate this day as a mini-anniversary, especially with the clinking of glasses filled with good wine.



Building Committee Update (January 15th and 16th Masses)

A Zoom Meeting was held last week. Participants were John Schiavone (CCSI), Dennis Kelly (CCSI), Ron Hadaway (Architect), and Dave Slezickey.

Kevin Herndon, DPH Certified Soil Classifier, recommended that we tie into the city sewage system or put a new septic system in behind the new social hall. This would necessitate removing trees and additional grading, which the additional

cost was not initially included in our budget. In addition, the area where the existing septic system is located is not large enough to accommodate the expansion. Soil percolation (water trickling through the dirt) is slightly better behind the new building. If we elect to tie into the city sewage system, most likely both the existing hall and the Church will also be connected. John and Ron will secure pricing for both plans.

John recommended that a double door opening into the hall be used to make it easier to store things. That was agreeable by all.

Ron is to provide new drawing changing the door.

John/Ron to get roof truss pricing from a manufacturer.

Richard Chalk will talk to Ron regarding IT requirements and location of AV Storage Rack.

John sent drawings on the construction of the Church. Dave will check with Marion Rice to make sure they are the correct ones. Both Marion and Dave agree that they are the same.

Dave is to give Ron a toilet/sink count in the church.

Drawings are moving along satisfactorily.

A scope letter will be sent out to all prospective bidders asking if they are interested in quoting on the project.

Plans and specifications will be released for pricing the middle of February.
