The month of April (Overview - Calendar) is dedicated to the Holy Spirit. To believe in the Holy Spirit is to profess that the Holy Spirit is one of the persons of the Holy Trinity, consubstantial with the Father and

the Son: "with the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified." (Catechism of the Catholic Church)

The Holy Spirit is the Person of Love in the life of God. He is also like a breath, an aspiration of infinite Love, from which we draw the breath of life.

On the day of Pentecost the Divine Spirit communicated such an abundance of life to the whole Church that to symbolize it "there came a sound from heaven, as of a violent wind coming, and it filled the whole house where they (the Apostles) were sitting."

But it is also for us that the Holy Spirit has come, for the group in the Cenacle represented the whole Church. The Holy Spirit came to remain with the Church forever. This is the promise of Jesus Himself. He dwells in the Church permanently and unfailingly, performing in it without ceasing His action of life-giving and sanctification. He establishes the Church infallibly in the truth. It is He Who makes the Church blossom forth with a marvelous supernatural fruitfulness, for He brings to life and full fruition in Virgins, Martyrs, and Confessors those heroic virtues which are one of the marks of true sanctity. (*The Mysteries of the Rosary, Dom Columba Marmion, O.S.B.*)

PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD PASSION

MEDITATION: 04/02/2023

“Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord” (Matthew 21:1-11)

Does the King of glory find a welcome entry in your home and heart? Jesus went to Jerusalem knowing full well what awaited him – betrayal, rejection, and crucifixion. The people of Jerusalem, however, were ready to hail him as their Messianic King! Little did they know what it would cost this king to usher in his kingdom. Jesus’ entry into Jerusalem astride a colt was a direct fulfillment of the Messianic prophecy of Zechariah (9:9):

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion. Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem. Lo, your king comes to you; triumphant and victorious is he, and riding on an donkey and upon a colt the foal of a donkey.

Those who believe, hope, and love receive Christ’s kingdom of peace and eternal life. The colt was a sign of peace. Jesus enters Jerusalem in meekness and humility, as the Messianic King who offers victory and peace to his people. That victory and peace would be secured in the cross and resurrection which would soon take place at the time of Passover.

Augustine, the great 5th century church father, comments on the significance of Jesus’ entry into Jerusalem:

“The master of humility is Christ who humbled himself and became obedient even to death, even the death of the cross. Thus he does not lose his divinity when he teaches us humility... What great thing was it to the king of the ages to become the king of humanity? For Christ was not the king of Israel so that he might exact a tax or equip an army with weaponry and visibly vanquish an enemy. He was the king of Israel in that he rules minds, in that he gives counsel for eternity, in that he leads into the kingdom of heaven for those who believe, hope, and love. It is a condescension, not an advancement for one who is the Son of God, equal to the Father, the Word through whom all things were made, to become king of Israel. It is an indication of pity, not an increase in power.” (Tractates on John 51.3-4)

Psalms 24 is another prophetic passage which echoes this triumphal procession of the King of glory: Lift up your heads, O gates! and be lifted up, O ancient doors! that the King of glory may come in.

Jesus Christ came to bring us the kingdom of God. He is the true King who offers peace, joy, and everlasting life for those who accept his kingship. Does the King of glory find a welcome entry in your heart and home? Do your walls echo with the praise of his glory?

“Lord Jesus, be the King and Ruler of my heart, mind, life, and home. May my life reflect your meekness and humility that you may be honored as the King of glory!”

CHÚA NHẬT LỄ LÁ CUỘC KHỔ NẠN CỦA CHÚA

SUY NIỆM: 04/02/2023

Chúc tụng Đức Vua, Đấng nhân danh Chúa mà đến

Đức Vua vinh hiển có tìm được sự đón tiếp khi bước vào gia đình và tâm hồn của bạn không? Đức Giêsu tiến vào Giêrusalem và biết rõ những gì đang chờ đợi Người – sự phản bội, chống đối, và sự đóng đinh. Tuy nhiên, dân thành Giêrusalem đang chờ đợi tung hô Người như Vị Vua Mê-sia! Ít người biết được điều gì mà vị Vua này sẽ phải trả giá để mở ra vương quốc của Người. Sự tiến vào thành Giêrusalem của Đức Giêsu ngồi trên lưng lừa con là sự ứng nghiệm lời tiên báo trực tiếp của ngôn sứ Giacaria (9,9) về Đấng Mê-sia:

Hãy vui mừng hoan hỷ, hỡi thiếu nữ Sion. Hãy vui sướng reo hò, hỡi thiếu nữ Giêrusalem. Vì Đức Vua của người đang đến với người; Người là Đấng chính trực, Đấng toàn thắng, khiêm tốn ngồi trên lưng lừa, một con lừa con vẫn còn theo mẹ.

Những ai tin cậy và yêu mến sẽ lãnh nhận sự bình an của nước Chúa và sự sống đời đời

Lừa là dấu hiệu của sự bình an. Đức Giêsu vào thành Giêrusalem trong sự hiền lành và khiêm nhường, với tư cách là Vị Vua Mê-sia, Đấng đem lại chiến thắng và bình an cho dân mình. Sự chiến thắng và bình an đó sẽ được bảo đảm trong thập giá và sự phục sinh, sẽ diễn ra trong dịp lễ Vượt Qua.

Thánh Augustine thành Hippo nhận định về ý nghĩa của việc vào thành Giêrusalem của Đức Giêsu như sau:

“Vị Thầy của sự khiêm nhường là Đức Kitô, Đấng tự hạ và trở nên vâng phục cho đến chết, và chết trên thập giá. Do đó, Người không đánh mất sự thánh thiện của mình khi dạy chúng ta về sự khiêm nhường. Điều lạ lùng nào đã khiến cho Đức Vua của các thế hệ phải trở nên vị Vua khiêm tốn như vậy? Vì Đức Kitô không phải là Vua của dân Israel, để Người có thể bắt người ta nộp thuế, hay để trang bị quân đội với vũ khí để đánh bại kẻ thù. Người là Vua của Israel, trong đó Người điều khiển tâm trí, trong đó Người hướng dẫn về sự sống đời đời, trong đó Người dẫn dắt những ai tin tưởng, hy vọng, và yêu mến vào vương quốc Thiên đàng. Đó là sự hạ mình, không phải là sự thắng tiến cho Đấng là Con Thiên Chúa, ngang hàng với Chúa Cha, là Ngôi Lời mà qua Người, tất cả mọi sự được tạo thành, trở nên Vua của dân Israel. Đó là dấu chỉ của lòng thương xót, chứ không phải để gia tăng quyền lực.” (Khảo luận về Tin mừng Gioan 51,3-4)

Thánh vịnh 24 là một lời tiên tri khác, nói lên cuộc rước chiến thắng này của Đức Vua vinh hiển: Ngẩng đầu lên, hỡi cửa thành! Cao lên nữa, hỡi cửa thành cổ kính! Vì Đức Vua vinh hiển ngự vào.

Đức Giêsu Kitô đến để đem lại cho chúng ta vương quốc của Thiên Chúa. Người là Đức Vua đích thật, Đấng ban sự bình an, niềm vui, và sự sống vĩnh cửu cho những ai đón nhận vương quyền của Người. Đức Vua vinh hiển có tìm được sự đón tiếp khi bước vào tâm hồn và gia đình của bạn không? Những bức tường của bạn có vang lên lời ngợi khen vinh quang của Người không?

“Lạy Chúa Giêsu, xin hãy làm Vua và làm Đấng cai quản linh hồn con, tâm trí con, và gia đình con. Chớ gì cuộc đời của con phản ánh sự hiền lành và khiêm nhường của Chúa để Chúa có thể được kính trọng như Đức Vua vinh quang!”

Building Project Update

Members of the Building Committee as well as some other interested parishioners met last Wednesday, March 22nd. There have been several issues concerning the connection of our new Parish Life Center and the city sewer system. This has caused a major delay in our construction plans. As a result, the Building Committee has decided to go with a septic tank system instead. The new septic system will need to be designed and approved by the City.

It has also been determined that the funding raised through our Capital Campaign will not cover the current cost of both phases of the project, therefore the committee has decided to proceed with phase one (the building of the New Parish Life Center) and put off phase two until additional funding for the renovation of the old social hall into classrooms can be procured. As soon as we have an updated quotation from the low bidder, we will petition the archbishop's permission to begin construction.

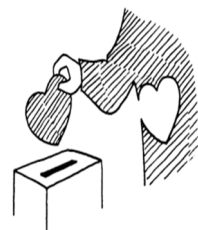
