Background on the Gospel Reading

Mark places this incident at Caesarea Philippi. Luke, because of the importance he wishes to give to prayer in his Gospel, places it in the context of Jesus praying. But Matthew keeps it at Caesarea Philippi. In today's Gospel, Jesus asks the disciples for a "field report" by asking what people are saying about him. He refers to himself as the Son of Man, a term derived from the Jewish Scriptures, found in the book of Daniel and in other apocryphal writings. Many scholars suggest that "Son of Man" is best understood to mean "human being."

As Jesus turns the question directly to the disciples and asks what they believe, Peter speaks for all of them when he announces that they believe Jesus to be the Christ. "Christ" is the Greek translation of the Hebrew word for "messiah," which means "the anointed one." At the time of Jesus, the image of the "messiah" was laden with popular expectations, most of which looked for a political leader who would free the Jewish people from Roman occupation.

Because Jesus has referred to himself a number of times in Matthew by Christological titles this moment is not the revelation of who Jesus is as in Mark. Instead it marks an important moment in the development of the Church. Jesus uses this occasion to bless Peter, who represents all the disciples but also has a unique role to play in the founding of the new community. Peter is blessed not because of a personal insight but because God revealed to him who Jesus is. Peter is the rock on which Jesus will build the Church.



San Pedro y San Pablo, Apóstoles - Ciclo C Domingo, 29 de junio de 2025

Antecedentes de la lectura del Evangelio

Marcos sitúa este incidente en Cesárea de Filipo. Lucas, debido a la importancia que desea dar a la oración en su Evangelio, lo sitúa en el contexto de Jesús orando. Pero Mateo lo mantiene en Cesárea de Filipo. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús pregunta a los discípulos por un "informe de campo" al preguntar qué dice la gente sobre él. Se refiere a sí mismo como el Hijo del Hombre, un término derivado de las Escrituras judías, que se encuentra en el libro de Daniel y en otros escritos apócrifos. Muchos eruditos sugieren que "Hijo del Hombre" se entiende mejor como "ser humano."

A medida que Jesús dirige la pregunta directamente a los discípulos y pregunta en qué creen, Pedro habla por todos ellos cuando anuncia que creen que Jesús es el Cristo. "Cristo" es la traducción griega de la palabra hebrea para "mesías", que significa "el ungido". En el tiempo de Jesús, la imagen del "mesías" estaba cargada de expectativas populares, la mayoría de las cuales buscaban un líder político que liberara al pueblo judío de la ocupación romana.

Porque Jesús se ha referido a sí mismo varias veces en Mateo con títulos cristológicos, este momento no es la revelación de quién es Jesús como en Marcos. En cambio, marca un momento importante en el desarrollo de la Iglesia. Jesús usa esta ocasión para bendecir a Pedro, quien representa a todos los discípulos, pero también tiene un papel único en la fundación de la nueva comunidad. Pedro es bendecido no por un conocimiento personal, sino porque Dios le reveló quién es Jesús. Pedro es la roca sobre la que Jesús edificará la Iglesia.
