Background on the Gospel Reading

In chapter 14 of Luke's Gospel, Jesus is speaking to people gathered at the table about the difficulties of following him. This group of people is suspicious about Jesus, looking to catch him doing something wrong. Jesus speaks to them in parables, emphasizing that although there is a right way to be a disciple and enter into the kingdom of his Father, it is a difficult path to follow. Many, even some of the guests at the table, reject the invitation. So Jesus turns to the crowds and speaks to them of discipleship. Jesus explains that, when it comes to making a choice for the Kingdom of God, nothing can get in the way. When Jesus describes "hating" one's father and mother, he is not talking about feelings. Rather, he is emphasizing very strongly that choosing to be a disciple means that everything else—family, money, your own life—must come second. In Matthew's version of this story (Matthew 10:37), Jesus refers not to "hating" father or mother, but to loving them more than Jesus. Jesus makes it very clear that being a disciple is not easy. It means to bear one's own cross. These difficult sayings of Jesus are followed by two brief parables (a person constructing a tower and a king marching into battle) that make an obvious point—don't start what you cannot finish. Discipleship is difficult and is something we can commit to only if we are prepared to put the Kingdom of God before everything else.



Vigésimo Tercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario , ciclo C 7 de septiembre 2025

Antecedentes de la lectura del Evangelio

En el capítulo 14 del Evangelio de Lucas, Jesús está hablando a las personas reunidas en la mesa sobre las dificultades de seguirlo. Este grupo de personas es sospechoso hacia Jesús, buscando atraparlo haciendo algo incorrecto. Jesús les habla en parábolas, enfatizando que, aunque hay una forma correcta de ser un discípulo y entrar en el reino de su Padre, es un camino difícil de seguir. Muchos, incluso algunos de los invitados a la mesa, rechazan la invitación. Entonces, Jesús se vuelve hacia las multitudes y les habla sobre el discipulado. Jesús explica que, cuando se trata de tomar una decisión por el Reino de Dios, nada puede interponerse en el camino. Cuando Jesús describe "odiar" a su padre y a su madre, no está hablando de sentimientos. Más bien, está enfatizando muy fuertemente que elegir ser un discípulo significa que todo lo demás—familia, dinero, tu propia vida—debe quedar en segundo plano. En la versión de esta historia de Mateo (Mateo 10:37), Jesús no se refiere a "odiar" al padre o a la madre, sino a amarlos más que a Jesús. Jesús deja muy claro que ser un discípulo no es fácil. Significa cargar con la propia cruz. Estas difíciles enseñanzas de Jesús son seguidas por dos breves parábolas (una persona construyendo una torre y un rey marchando a la batalla) que hacen un punto obvio—no comiences lo que no puedes terminar. El discipulado es difícil y es algo a lo que solo podemos comprometernos si estamos dispuestos a poner el Reino de Dios por encima de todo lo demás.
