**Background on the Gospel Reading**

Today as a Church, we conclude our liturgical year and celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. The Gospel we proclaim shows the great mystery of our faith: In the moment of his crucifixion, Jesus is shown to be King and Savior of all.

Luke's Gospel has been loaded with surprises: the poor are rich, sinners find salvation, the Kingdom of God is found in our midst. Here we see the greatest surprise of all. We are confronted with the crucified Jesus, whom faith tells us is King and Savior of all. The irony is that the inscription placed on the cross, perhaps in mockery, contains the profoundest of truth. As the leaders jeer, the thief crucified by his side recognizes Jesus as Messiah and King, and finds salvation.

Jesus is King, but not the kind of king we might have imagined or expected. His kingship was hidden from many of his contemporaries, but those who had the eyes of faith were able to see. As modern disciples of Jesus, we, too, struggle at times to recognize Jesus as King. Today's Gospel invites us to make our own judgment. With eyes of faith, we, too, recognize that Jesus, the crucified One, is indeed King and Savior of all.

**Antecedentes sobre la lectura del Evangelio**

Hoy, como Iglesia, concluimos nuestro año litúrgico y celebramos la fiesta de Cristo Rey. El Evangelio que proclamamos revela el gran misterio de nuestra fe: en el momento de su crucifixión, Jesús se muestra como Rey y Salvador de todos.

El Evangelio de Lucas está repleto de sorpresas: los pobres son ricos, los pecadores encuentran la salvación, el Reino de Dios se halla entre nosotros. Aquí vemos la mayor sorpresa de todas. Nos encontramos ante Jesús crucificado, de quien la fe nos dice que es Rey y Salvador de todos. La ironía reside en que la inscripción colocada en la cruz, quizá en tono de burla, contiene la verdad más profunda. Mientras los líderes se mofan, el ladrón crucificado a su lado reconoce a Jesús como Mesías y Rey, y encuentra la salvación.

Jesús es Rey, pero no el tipo de rey que podríamos haber imaginado o esperado. Su realeza permaneció oculta para muchos de sus contemporáneos, pero aquellos que tenían ojos de fe pudieron verla. Como discípulos modernos de Jesús, también nosotros luchamos a veces por reconocerlo como Rey. El Evangelio de hoy nos invita a discernirlo por nosotros mismos. Con ojos de fe, también nosotros reconocemos que Jesús, el crucificado, es en verdad Rey y Salvador de todos.
