## FROM FR. CHUCK

HAPPY NOVEMBER! If you are reading this on Sunday morning, I hope you remembered to turn your clocks back. ☺ Of course, most will tell me these days, "My phone changed automatically!" Ahh, I guess for some, gone are the days of changing all your clocks in the house.

I've been enjoying a couple of weeks off and am grateful for Fr. Cyrus who is speaking this weekend to share about the important work of **Unbound**, which reaches out in support of poor children and the elderly. Please give him a warm Reno welcome – and the same for all visiting our good parish this weekend.

Today begins **National Vocations Awareness Week**. During this week we focus on increasing the awareness for us all that a "vocation" is something we all have and thus all must discern. Naturally we consider the dearth of vocations to priesthood and religious life, for we desperately need that witness and leadership in the Church. We also consider the vocations of lay leadership, faithful single life, marriage, and family, all equally crucial in our Church. Monday through Friday of this week we will observe an hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament for vocation awareness. Adoration time of prayer will begin at 5:00 PM each day and will conclude with simple benediction at 6:00 PM. All are encouraged to spend time in prayer during this week for vocations and, if possible, to come for part or all of this holy hour during the week, joining our Vocation Awareness Team here at the Cathedral.

As many of you know I was supposed to be in the Holy Land for this time off. It got cancelled due to the war in the region. I went to Boston to join my priest friend and we drove up to Maine. We were not that far from Lewiston, the town of the horrible, mass shooting. We were going to a play the night after it happened, but since the shooter was still at large they canceled the play. Obviously, the growing influence of violence in our world is very much on my mind. Anger, hatred, revenge, pain, loss, and suffering continue to multiply, and it can seem so beyond our ability to repair. As Malachi notes in our first reading, "*Have we not all the one father? Has not the one God created us? Why then do we break faith with one another, violating the covenant of our fathers?*" We must continue to pray and work toward the different way Jesus Christ showed us, the new covenant, one that is grounded in compassion rather than revenge and that begins within us. It begins, as St. Francis of Assisi noted, with a deep desire to understand rather than to be understood first.

As I'm typing this, I am waiting for the report from the **Synod on Synodality** to be released in English. However, it is clear from commentary and the entire process of the Synod, that listening and understanding each other is its primary mode. The goal is the journey, perhaps life long, that makes us grow as a human race into the image that God created us to be, one human family.

## DEL PADRE CHUCK

**¡FELIZ NOVIEMBRE!** Si está leyendo mis notas el domingo por la mañana, espero que haya recordado atrasar su reloj una hora. ☺ Por supuesto, la mayoría me dirá en estos días: "*¡Mi teléfono cambió automáticamente!*" Supongo que, para algunos, se acabaron los días de cambiar todos los relojes de la casa.

He estado disfrutando de un par de semanas de descanso y agradezco al Padre Cyrus, quien está de visita este fin de semana para compartir sobre el importante trabajo de **Unbound**, en apoyo por niños y ancianos pobres. Por favor, denle una cálida bienvenida al igual que a todos los que visiten nuestra parroquia este fin de semana.

Hoy comienza la **Semana Nacional de Concientización Vocacional**. Durante esta semana nos enfocaremos en aumentar conocimiento de que una "vocación" es algo que todos tenemos y, por lo tanto, todos debemos discernir. Naturalmente, tomamos en cuenta la escasez de vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa, pues necesitamos desesperadamente ese testimonio y liderazgo en la Iglesia. También consideramos que las vocaciones del liderazgo laico, la vida de soltero fiel, el matrimonio y la familia, son igualmente cruciales en nuestra Iglesia. Esta semana, de lunes a viernes, observaremos una hora de oración ante el Santísimo Sacramento por la concientización vocacional. La oración frente al Santísimo comenzará a las 5:00 PM y concluirá con una bendición simple a las 6:00 PM. Todos están invitados a pasar tiempo en oración durante esta semana por las vocaciones y, si es posible, a venir a esta hora santa, uniéndose a nuestro Equipo por las Vocaciones aquí en la Catedral.

Como saben, se supone que debería estar en Tierra Santa durante este tiempo libre. El peregrinaje se canceló debido a la guerra en la región. Fui a Boston para reunirme con mi amigo sacerdote y nos fuimos manejando a Maine. Estábamos muy cerca de la ciudad del horrible tiroteo masivo, Lewiston. íbamos a ver una obra de teatro la noche después del tiroteo, pero como el tirador todavía estaba prófugo, la obra fue cancelada. Obviamente, la creciente influencia de la violencia en nuestro mundo está muy presente en mi mente. La ira, el odio, la venganza, el dolor, la pérdida y el sufrimiento continúan multiplicándose, y puede parecer que está más allá de nuestra capacidad de reparación. Como señala Malaquías en la primera lectura: "¿No tenemos todos un solo Padre? ¿Acaso Dios no nos ha creado? ¿Por qué, pues, quebrantamos la fe los unos con los otros, violando el pacto de nuestros padres?" Debemos continuar orando y trabajando hacia la forma diferente que Jesucristo nos mostró, el nuevo pacto, uno que se basa en la compasión en lugar de la venganza y que comienza dentro de nosotros. Como señaló San Francisco de Asís, comienza con un profundo deseo de comprender en lugar de ser entendido primero.


