## FROM FR. CHUCK

**Greetings on this Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord!** A special day to celebrate and remember that Jesus did not abandon us but trusted us to carry forward all that he had taught. Yet, we heard him say in last Sunday's gospel, "I will not leave you orphans," for he went forth promising to send the Holy Spirit (the gift we will celebrate next week) to guide and be with us. And, as one with the Father and the Spirit, the risen Jesus Christ promises that he will be with us "always, until the end of the age." Matt. 28:20. These are important words to hold onto when we are struggling or wondering where we are going as a human race. I find great hope in that our loving and creating God has empowered us to care for all that he made. For if God does not exist in time and sees all as now, and if God is all good, then, as Julian of Norwich said, "All shall be well, and all shall be well, and all manner of thing shall be well." Now, that is hope!

We welcome **Fr. Steve Blum** this weekend. Fr. Steve is a retired priest of the Diocese of Toledo, Ohio and a representative of **Food for the Poor**, an excellent organization that serves the poorest of the poor. I encourage your support for the work they do, having witnessed it firsthand when I joined Food for the Poor on a mission trip to Nicaragua some years ago. Welcome Fr. Steve!

From Monday evening, May 22 to Friday, May 26, the priests of the Diocese of Reno will join with our bishop on retreat at Christ the King Retreat Center in Citrus Heights, east of Sacramento. This is as our annual retreat and one of two times each year the priests have some quality time together in prayer, reflection, and fellowship. Archbishop Peter Sartain, retired from the Archdiocese of Seattle, will be our retreat director. Know that you will be lifted in prayer during these days and please keep your priests in prayer as well. Mass will be celebrated at the Cathedral on Monday, May 22, at 12:10 PM as usual, but there will be no other weekday Mass here nor the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Thursday. Adoration will take place from 1:00-5:30 PM on Thursday.

In the absence of the priests, this week is a good time to reflect on the gift of the availability of daily Mass and to pray for vocations, especially to the priesthood. Starting next weekend, we hope to have families and individuals ready to commit to praying for vocations each day for a week at a time. They will be sent home with a chalice as a reminder and symbol of service for the prayer. If you have not had the opportunity to sign up for this ministry, please do so today or call the parish office. The chalice and prayers will be exchanged at the 9:30 AM & 6:00 PM Masses each Sunday. Thank you for considering this new ministry. Of course, we don't need a chalice to pray for vocations. All are invited to be a part of this through your individual prayer as well. The kernel of prayer for vocations is that all the faithful be open to hearing what calling God has placed on their hearts and be willing to seek the strength to carry that out in the world.


Soon it will be one year since we began the "**Eucharistic Revival**" in our diocese and throughout the country. It officially began on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ in 2022 when we began our special time of silent thanksgiving after Communion, leaving the Blessed Sacrament on the altar and praying the Anima Christi (Soul of Christ) prayer. I think most have found this a helpful time to refocus on our belief in the real presence of Christ in the bread and wine we receive and to remember the call of thanksgiving. The very word, Eucharist, means thanksgiving. A time of quiet, known as sacred silence, always has been prescribed in the liturgy, though we often have taken little notice. I appreciated us getting used to this important time. It is a good reminder that we are supposed to have sacred silence after the Word of God is proclaimed as well.

The Eucharistic Revival begins its second year on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ on June 11. Now that we have refocused on the presence of Christ in the Eucharist, we will no longer leave the Blessed Sacrament on the altar after Communion, for, as we have been saying this past year,

the same presence of Christ is in each of us who receive. We'll continue observing sacred silence after Communion to give thanks and then we will recite together a prayer adapted from St. Teresa of Avila's famous remembrance that "Christ has no body on earth but yours." The primary goal that Bishop Mueggenborg has for us in the Eucharistic Revival in the Diocese of Reno is that all will realize we receive the true Body and Blood of Christ so that we may be that active presence of the Body of Christ in the world. St. Teresa's prayer is perfect to challenge us to do just that. The United States Bishops have asked that we collectively around the country have Eucharistic processions on the solemnity this year. Our bishop has asked that we do this after one of the weekend Masses. In order to help us connect that presence of Christ in the Eucharist to the active presence of Christ in us, I would like us to prepare sandwiches to distribute to the poor on our streets as we walk in procession. More details on this will be forthcoming but I think it would be an excellent way for us to connect service to the Blessed Sacrament.

I'm leading the Engaged Encounter Retreat this weekend, please remember to pray for the engaged couples on the retreat and all those who are planning to marry.

## **DEL PADRE CHUCK**

¡Saludos en esta **Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor!** Un día especial para celebrar y recordar que Jesús no nos abandonó, sino que confió en nosotros para llevar adelante todo lo que nos había enseñado. Sin embargo, lo escuchamos decir en el evangelio del domingo pasado: "No los dejaré huérfanos", porque nos prometió enviar al Espíritu Santo (el don que celebraremos la próxima semana) para guiarnos y estar con nosotros. Y, como uno con el Padre y el Espíritu, Jesucristo resucitado promete que estará con nosotros "siempre, hasta el fin del mundo". Mateo 28:20. Estas son palabras importantes a las que nos aferrarnos cuando tenemos dificultades o preguntándonos a dónde vamos como raza humana. Encuentro una gran esperanza en que nuestro Dios amoroso y creador nos ha dado poder para cuidar de todo lo que hizo. Porque si Dios no existe en el tiempo y ve todo como ahora, y si Dios es todo bueno, entonces, como dijo Juliana de Norwich, "Todo estará bien, y todo estará bien, y todas las cosas estarán bien". ¡Ahora, eso es esperanza!

Damos la bienvenida al **Padre Steve Blum** este fin de semana. El Padre Steve es un sacerdote jubilado de la Diócesis de Toledo, Ohio y viene representando de **Food for the Poor**, una excelente organización que sirve a los más pobres de los pobres. Aliento su apoyo para el trabajo que hacen, después de haberlo presenciado de primera mano cuando me uní a Food for the Poor en un viaje misionero a Nicaragua hace algunos años. ¡Bienvenido Padre Steve!

Desde el lunes 22 de mayo por la tarde hasta el viernes 26 de mayo, los sacerdotes de la Diócesis de Reno nos uniremos a nuestro obispo en un retiro en el Centro Christ the King al este de Sacramento California. Este es nuestro retiro anual y una de las dos veces al año que los sacerdotes tienen un tiempo de calidad juntos en oración, reflexión y compañerismo. El arzobispo Peter Sartain, retirado de la Arquidiócesis de Seattle, será nuestro director del retiro. Sepan que estarán en nuestras oraciones y por favor mantengan a sus sacerdotes en oración también.

La Misa del lunes 22 de mayo a las 12:10 PM se celebrará como de costumbre, pero no se celebrarán más Misas el resto de la semana aquí en la Catedral. No tendremos confesiones el jueves. Adoración al Santísimo será de 1:00--5:30 PM.

En ausencia de los sacerdotes esta semana, considere reflexionar sobre el don de la disponibilidad de la Misa diaria y el orar por las vocaciones, especialmente al sacerdocio. A partir del próximo fin de semana, esperamos tener familias e individuos listos para comprometerse a orar por las vocaciones cada día durante una semana. Serán enviados a casa con un cáliz como recordatorio y símbolo de servicio para la oración. Si no ha tenido la oportunidad de inscribirse en este ministerio, hágalo hoy o llame a la oficina parroquial. El cáliz y las oraciones se intercambiarán en las Misas de 9:30 AM y 6:00 PM cada domingo. Gracias por considerar este nuevo ministerio. Por supuesto, no necesitamos un cáliz para orar por las vocaciones. Todos están invitados a ser parte de esto a través de su oración individual también. El núcleo de la oración por las vocaciones es que todos los fieles estén abiertos a escuchar lo que Dios ha puesto en sus corazones y estén dispuestos a buscar la fuerza para llevarla a cabo en el mundo.

Pronto se cumplirá un año desde que comenzamos el "**Avivamiento Eucarístico**" en nuestra diócesis y en todo el país. Comenzó oficialmente en la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo en 2022 cuando comenzamos nuestro tiempo especial de acción de gracias silenciosa después de la Comunión, dejando el Santísimo Sacramento en el altar y rezando la oración Anima Christi (Alma de Cristo). Creo que la mayoría ha encontrado este un momento útil para volver a enfocarnos en nuestra creencia en la presencia real de Cristo en el pan y el vino que recibimos y para recordar el llamado de acción de gracias. La misma palabra, Eucaristía, significa acción de gracias. Un tiempo de silencio, conocido como silencio sagrado, siempre ha sido prescrito en la liturgia, aunque a menudo hemos prestado poca atención. Aprecié que nos acostumbráramos a este momento importante. Es un buen recordatorio de que se supone que debemos tener un silencio sagrado después de que se proclame la Palabra de Dios también.

El Avivamiento Eucarístico comienza su segundo año en la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo el 11 de junio. Ahora que nos hemos vuelto a centrar en la presencia de Cristo en la Eucaristía, ya no dejaremos el Santísimo Sacramento en el altar después de la Comunión, porque, como hemos estado diciendo el año pasado, la misma presencia de Cristo está en cada uno de nosotros que recibimos. Continuaremos observando el silencio sagrado después de la Comunión para dar gracias y luego recitaremos juntos una oración adaptada del famoso recuerdo de Santa Teresa de Ávila de que "Cristo no tiene cuerpo en la tierra sino el tuyo". El objetivo principal que el Obispo Mueggenborg tiene para nosotros en el Avivamiento Eucarístico en la Diócesis de Reno es que todos se den cuenta de que recibimos el verdadero Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo para que podamos ser esa presencia activa del Cuerpo de Cristo en el mundo. La oración de Santa Teresa es perfecta para desafiarnos a hacer precisamente eso. Los obispos de los Estados Unidos han pedido que colectivamente en todo el país tengamos procesiones eucarísticas en la solemnidad de este año. Nuestro obispo nos ha pedido que hagamos esto después de una de las misas del fin de semana. Para ayudarnos a conectar esa presencia de Cristo en la Eucaristía con la presencia activa de Cristo en nosotros, me gustaría que preparáramos sándwiches para distribuir a los pobres en nuestras calles mientras caminamos en procesión. Más detalles sobre esto estarán por venir, pero creo que sería una excelente manera para que conectemos el servicio con el Santísimo Sacramento.

Estoy dirigiendo el Retiro de Encuentro Comprometido este fin de semana, por favor recuerden orar por las parejas comprometidas en el retiro y todos aquellos que planean casarse.

### EUCARISTIC PRAYER #10—THE MYSTERY OF FAITH

“When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your death, O Lord, until you come again.”

Excerpt from the Roman Missal

After the words of Consecration, the priest will proclaim “The Mystery of Faith.” However, when the priest proclaims those words, he isn’t inviting the people to say what the mystery of faith is. Rather, he is declaring that the Mystery of Faith is present here and now; he is speaking of the Eucharist on the altar. The Eucharist is the mystery of our faith. The response we make is our belief in what that means for us: That Christ’s sacrifice and our participation in it through the Eucharist brings us life.
