

FROM FR. CHUCK

Happy Father's Day! Today we lift up all our dads, living and deceased, especially those who have touched the lives of their children with profound faith, hope and love. There are many names for "father" within our society, including Papa, Pop, Pa, Dad, Daddy, Dada, Baba, even the "old man," to name a few. I'm sure there are many other endearing nicknames that children and grandchildren come up with to refer to the person and role of the one who shows them how to do things, how to act, and how to love. For many, those are or have been good examples and for others not so good. Today we lift them all up in prayers of thanksgiving and, perhaps, in prayers for healing. Thank you, fathers, for the many times you have sacrificed for us, your daughters and sons, and for the many things you have taught us about growing up and living in this world!

By way of a Church father, we are experiencing a shift within the dioceses of Las Vegas, Salt City and Reno. At the foundation of the Diocese of Reno in 1931, we were the whole state of Nevada and we were made part of the Church ecclesiastical province, also known as the "Metropolitan See," of the Archdiocese of San Francisco. With the tremendous growth in southern Nevada, our diocesan name changed to the Diocese of Reno-Las Vegas in the 1980's but by 1995, as southern Nevada continued to grow much faster than the north, a new diocese was created known as the Diocese of Las Vegas. Technically, the "new" Diocese of Reno was created also as the lines were drawn creating each diocese. Through all these years, both dioceses have remained part of the Archdiocese of San Francisco – until last month. On May 30, 2023, Pope Francis created the **Archdiocese of Las Vegas** and placed the dioceses of Reno and Salt Lake City (also formerly part of the Archdiocese of San Francisco) within this new ecclesiastical province. George Thomas, Bishop of Las Vegas was then elevated to the role of the first Archbishop of Las Vegas.

What does all this mean for the Diocese of Reno? In the day-to-day life of our diocese, this change means very little. Bishop Daniel Mueggenborg remains our chief shepherd, ultimately answerable to Pope Francis. Our new archbishop convenes the bishops of his province for meetings and helps direct the administration of certain ecclesial matters that pertain to the dioceses, especially for purposes of unity and consistency both within the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops as well as the Church worldwide. This is important but doesn't effect the lives of most Catholics in our diocese. Many never were aware that we were part of the province of San Francisco so now that we are a part of the province of Las Vegas, it won't matter much. However, in the historic and ecclesial life of these dioceses, it is a significant change. Archbishop Thomas said, "This really is a remarkable legacy and moment in Las Vegas, and for the Catholic Church as a whole. With our Diocese being elevated to an Archdiocese, Pope Francis has discerned the need for a new Ecclesiastical Province in the Western United States." So congratulations to Archbishop Thomas and to all of us in this acknowledgement of the Catholic Church in Nevada and Utah!

I would like to extend a special word of thanks to the Knights of Columbus, who hosted the mini-golf tournament for our parish last Saturday. The weather held out and it was a delightful morning, concluding with lunch. We all had a good time and enjoyed each other's company. See the photos later in the bulletin. **THANK YOU KNIGHTS!**

Another word of thanks goes out to all those who participated in the **Eucharistic Procession** last Sunday, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We had about 60 marchers, led by the Blessed Sacrament, carrying lunches made by some of them and other parish volunteers. The lunches were handed out to those experiencing homelessness or difficult times as we walked in procession from the Cathedral to Catholic Charities. All the lunches were given out, along with warm-weather hygiene kits and bus passes provided by Catholic Charities. We sang songs with a Eucharistic theme as we walked. It was beautiful to see and, I suspect, perhaps a first in Reno. Many remarked how impactful it was to be processing with the Body of Christ while sharing food with the hungry. Thank you to all who walked or helped out in any way. Be sure to check out the pics later in this bulletin.

Fr. Beda will leave this Thursday for vacation for a couple weeks. Wish him well when you see him. Fathers Mike Mahone and John McGuire will be helping with some masses in his absence – thank these joyful, retired priests for their continued service for us and in our diocese.

DEL PADRE CHUCK

¡Feliz Día del Padre! Hoy reconocemos a todos los padres, vivos y difuntos, especialmente a aquellos que han tocado las vidas de sus hijos con profunda fe, esperanza y amor. Hay muchos nombres para "padre" dentro de nuestra sociedad, incluyendo Papa, Pop, Pa, Dad, Daddy, Dada, Baba, incluso "Viejo". Estoy seguro de que hay muchos otros apodos que se les ocurren a los hijos y nietos para referirse a la persona y el papel de quien les muestra cómo hacer las cosas, cómo actuar y cómo amar. Para muchos, esos son o han sido buenos ejemplos y para otros no tan buenos. Hoy los recordamos en oraciones de acción de gracias y, tal vez, en oraciones por su salud. ¡Gracias, padres, por las muchas veces que se han sacrificado por nosotros, sus hijos y por las tantas cosas que nos han enseñado sobre crecer y vivir en este mundo!

A través de un padre de la Iglesia, estamos experimentando un cambio dentro de las diócesis de Las Vegas, Salt City y Reno. En la fundación de la Diócesis de Reno en 1931, éramos todo el estado de Nevada y formamos parte de la provincia eclesiástica conocida como la "Sede Metropolitana", de la Arquidiócesis de San Francisco. Con el crecimiento en el sur de Nevada, en la década de los 80s, nuestro nombre diocesano cambió a la Diócesis de Reno-Las Vegas y en 1995, a medida que el sur de Nevada continuaba creciendo mucho más rápido que el norte, se creó una nueva diócesis, la Diócesis de Las Vegas. Técnicamente, la "nueva" Diócesis de Reno fue creada también como las líneas fueron trazadas creando cada diócesis. A lo largo de todos estos años, ambas diócesis han permanecido como parte de la Arquidiócesis de San Francisco. El 30 de mayo, el Papa Francisco creó la Arquidiócesis de **Las Vegas** y colocó las diócesis de Reno y Salt Lake City (también anteriormente parte de la Arquidiócesis de San Francisco) dentro de esta nueva provincia eclesiástica. George Thomas, obispo de Las Vegas, fue elevado al papel de primer arzobispo de Las Vegas.

¿Qué significa todo esto para la Diócesis de Reno? En el día a día de nuestra diócesis, este cambio significa poco. El obispo Daniel Mueggenborg sigue siendo nuestro pastor principal, en última instancia responsable ante el Papa Francisco. Nuestro nuevo arzobispo convoca a los obispos de su provincia para reuniones y ayuda a dirigir la administración de ciertos asuntos eclesiásticos que pertenecen a las diócesis, especialmente para propósitos de unidad y consistencia, tanto dentro de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de EE. UU., como de la Iglesia en todo el mundo. Esto es importante, pero no afecta la vida de la mayoría de los católicos en nuestra diócesis. Muchos nunca supieron que éramos parte de la provincia de San Francisco. Sin embargo, en la vida histórica y eclesial de estas diócesis, es un cambio significativo. El arzobispo Thomas dijo: "Este es realmente un legado y un momento notable en Las Vegas y para la Iglesia Católica en general. Con nuestra Diócesis siendo elevada a Arquidiócesis, el Papa Francisco ha discernido la necesidad de una nueva Provincia Eclesiástica en el Oeste de EE. UU.". ¡Felicitaciones al Arzobispo Thomas y a nosotros en este reconocimiento de la Iglesia Católica en Nevada y Utah!
