Price, \$17 for unbaked strudels ready for the freezer to bake later. **Pick-up of Strudels will be on Sat., Oct. 30, from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. in drive-thru lines at the K.C. Hall. There will be no out-of-town deliveries.**

**Apple Donations:** The cost of the apples will be **\$35 per box** and we expect to use 60 boxes of apples. In past years, we've often received donations covering the cost of all the apples. Of course, we hope for the same this year! Donations may be left at the parish office or Patek Grocery.

**Cash Donations** of any amount are always welcome and appreciated! These may be left in the collection basket, at the parish office, or at Patek Grocery.

To give an idea of the cost of the supplies for this project, this is the estimated cost for this year, should someone be willing to pick up the tab for a particular item: sugar, \$250; flour, \$170; graham crumbs, \$320; coconut, \$125; raisins, \$150; margarine, \$175; butter, \$600.

**Pecans:** Your donations of shelled pecans will surely be a big help. Thank you to those who have already made donations. Pecans may be left at the parish office anytime during regular hours.
