<u>Feast of the Presentation of the Lord</u> <u>February 2, 2022</u>

Mass by Candlelight

On Wednesday, February 2nd we will celebrate the *Feast of the Presentation*, the day on which the eyes of St. Simeon fell upon the radiant Light, Our Lord Jesus Christ. We recall in the Canticle of Simeon that Our Blessed Lord is "a Light to the revelation of the Gentiles and the glory of the people of Israel (Luke 2:29-31). We also call this feast "*Candlemas*" or "*Candeleria*" in Spanish. Traditionally, the blessing of all the beeswax candles for the year would take place on this day. Candles would be used in a procession by the faithful into the Church symbolizing the Light of Christ entering the temple.

We will celebrate this feast according to the custom of the Church in a Mass by candlelight on Wednesday, February 2, at 6:00 p.m. Many candles will be lit throughout the Church, but the electric lights will be mostly off.

You are also encouraged to bring candles you would like blessed for the year, though you can get them blessed at other times as well. A pious custom is to burn these candles on the anniversary of the death of loved ones, on All Souls Day, when reciting the prayer against storms, and on any other occasions of prayer and intercession throughout the year.

Pro-Life Eucharistic Procession Sunday, January 23, 2022, 2:00 p.m.

This year marks the 11th year of our annual parish Eucharistic Procession when we gather to pray for an end to legalized abortion in our country and a greater respect for all life. This service is a public expression of our faith in the Eucharist and belief in the dignity of life – from conception to natural death. <u>Parishioners</u> and the general public are invited to participate.

- A bus ride from church to the park will be offered. Bus will leave at 1:30 from the church.
- **2:00 p.m.: Procession** begins at Welhausen Park to walk to church while praying the rosary.
- All parish organizations are invited to participate while carrying their banners.
- All altar servers are invited to join the procession, vested in their albs.
- Those unable to walk in procession are invited to take part by spending time praying in church until the procession arrives for the closing prayers and Benediction.
- In case of inclement weather, the service will be held in church only.
