Installation of New Pastor & Welcome Reception

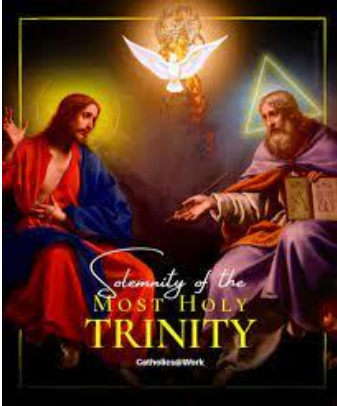
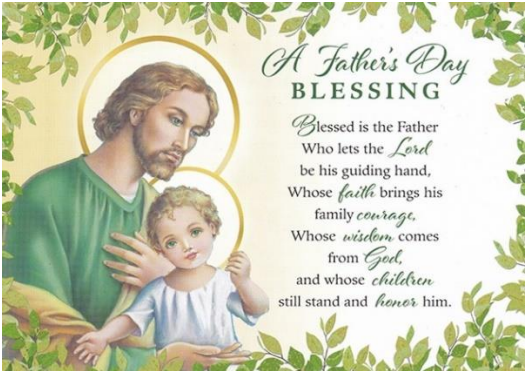

This Sunday in the Latin Church is the feast of the Most Holy Trinity (the first Sunday after Pentecost in both the Old and New forms of the Roman Rite). The Trinity is a central mystery of Christian faith, and the mystery of God's inner life. From 1759 until the introduction of the New Mass in 1970, it was specified that in the Roman Rite the Eucharistic Preface (the part following "it is truly right and just") should be said on every

Sunday following Pentecost. In practice that was not always the case but in the modern calendar we only recite it once a year. The text is rich and filled with much to reflect on:

It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God. For with your Only Begotten Son and the Holy Spirit you are one God, one Lord: not in the unity of a single person, but in a Trinity of one substance.

For what you have revealed to us of your glory we believe equally of your Son and of the Holy Spirit, so that, in the confessing of the true and eternal Godhead, you might be adored in what is proper to each Person, their unity in substance, and their equality in majesty.

For this is praised by Angels and Archangels, Cherubim, too, and Seraphim, who never cease to cry out each day, as with one voice they acclaim.

This, I must admit, appears to bear little relation to the way we came to know the mystery of God's inner life. As the Preface of the Most Holy Trinity describes the mystery of divinity, it is more an abstract doctrine to be held than an invitation to a new life. Almost mathematical in its approach, the prayer speaks of the Almighty in such philosophical and non-biblical terms that we seem to have lost something precious in our relation to God, in our very attempts to describe who God is. God's inner life is love, a union of giving among three Persons, is a
