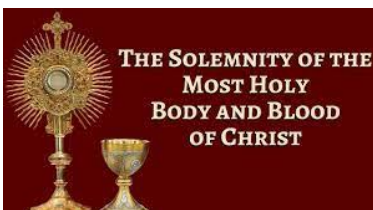

Gospel: Luke 9:11-17

Corpus Christi
(Body and Blood of
Christ) is a Eucharistic
solemnity. It is,
moreover, the

Church's official act of homage and gratitude to
Christ, who by instituting the Holy Eucharist gave
to the Church her greatest treasure.

Christ has arranged to remain with us under
the form of food for our spiritual sustenance in the
sacred sacrifice of the Mass, in which we can
partake of his sacred body and blood, soul and
divinity. How could he do that is only a small
mystery for our finite minds. He was God as well as
man. But *why* he should do this for us unworthy
creatures is the greater mystery by far. Infinite
love, which we finite beings cannot even begin to
understand, is the answer and the explanation.

Instead, then, of wasting any time on trying to
solve this mystery, which we know to be a fact, let
us try to thank him for it and use this gift of his love
as often as possible. This will be the greatest proof
that we appreciate this divine gift. We know that
we are not worthy to receive our divine Lord
"under our roof." But we also know that Jesus can
and will make us worthy if we ask him in all
sincerity: "to say but the word and we shall be
healed."
