This Sunday is the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and we are reminded of Christ victory over sin and death on the cross. Christ overcame hatred, lies, and devilish deceit as he rose victoriously from the



underworld on Easter Sunday. Thus, the cross reminds us of the warfare in which Christ won for us his ultimate victory. In this battle, if the evil one is the father of lies, and if much of the battle against him involves rejecting his lies and standing in the truth of God, we should be alert to the most insidious and destructive types of the devil's lies. They are: he lies to us about God; he lies to us about ourselves; and he lies to us about others. We need to be alert to these lies, quick to recognize them and firm in repudiating them.

Here's a key principle of spiritual warfare: the devil hates it when people live in harmony and mutual love, and he constantly tries to destroy the bonds that unite Christians, mainly by telling lies. We should take it as a matter of course that any important relationship we may have—with our spouses, our children, our neighbors, our colleagues and friends—will regularly come under attack. If we are to be intelligent fighters, we need to be aware of this and battle for our key relationships. We should be slow to allow our minds to run to suspicion, to impute motives, and to allow such thoughts to fester in darkness. Sometimes the lies come from the gossip of

other tongues. The devil delights to inspire slander and gossip, knowing how he can use them to destroy the work of God. Often enough the lie arises within ourselves, as the enemy suggests to our minds nasty things about those closest to us, playing upon our weaknesses and vulnerabilities, urging us to dwell on difficult things, inflaming our resentments and suggesting impure motives in others. He pulls at our own insecurities and tells us how unlovable we are. His aim is always to destroy trust and sow division. That is one reason why St. Paul urges us to deal with one another "with patience, forbearing one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace." Thus, it is essential that as we endure our day-to-day life and dutifully do our daily tasks that we remember all that is at stake. As we commemorate the Exaltation of the Cross may the Lord grant us a greater sense of diligence to remain steadfast in faith and to show the victory that he won for us on the cross against sin and death.
