Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners,

After last week's Gospel about the corrupt judge and the importance of perseverance in our prayer, Luke continues in Chapter 18 speaking of humility in our prayer. Jesus presents a parable about the prayer of the Pharisee and the tax collector. The Pharisee is proud and arrogant in his prayer while the tax collector is humble and acknowledges his sinfulness. We are reminded and encouraged by this parable to keep our prayer simple and humble. In our prayer life, we should be like the tax collector and not like the Pharisee. Sometimes we can think that we are better than other people because we come to church and attempt to lead a Holy life, and this is an example of us being like the Pharisee. We must strive to be more like the tax collector as we acknowledge that we are sinners who need God's love, compassion, and mercy.

Our prayer should not be a competition or comparison of our lives to other people but an acknowledgement of who we are as God's simple and humble people. When Jesus taught the disciples to pray, He gave them the "Our Father," which is a simple humble prayer, and He encourages us to be humble in our prayer.

There are many forms of prayer and devotions in our church because each of us needs to have a prayer style and / or devotion that leads us to God and not make us look better than our neighbor. We must find a prayer life that works for us like the example of the tax collector. In our prayer life, God invites us to be in union with Him as we communicate our thanks, praise, successes, failures, needs, and faith to Him.

PASTORAL SERVICES APPEAL UPDATE

Thank you to all who have contributed to the 2022 Pastoral Services Appeal (PSA). Our assigned goal this year is \$110,000. To date, there are 266 donors who have pledged \$125,720, of which \$111,432 has been received. This means we have already exceeded our goal, and anything above that goal will come back to us as a rebate. Because of your generosity, we have regularly exceeded our goal by a significant amount for the past several years. Based on this positive trend, our budget for the current fiscal year includes an anticipated PSA rebate of \$44,000. This means that between now and December 31, 2022, we hope to receive an additional \$28,280 over what has currently been donated.

If you have not yet donated to the 2022 PSA campaign, please consider making a contribution before the end of the year. Donation brochures are available in the Parish Office, or you can use the online option which can be accessed on the parish website. May God bless you for your generosity!


