### Pastor's Message


#### Dear Parishioners,

This week, our readings shift to how the birth of Jesus came about. We hear from the Gospel of Matthew about Mary being with child through the power of the Holy Spirit. Mary and Joseph were engaged to be married, but not yet married and the law was extremely strict against women found to be with child outside of marriage. Joseph was visited in a dream by an angel who said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her."

Sometimes we too need encouragement from God or an angel not to be afraid of something we may not understand or something that does not make sense to us. It is important to always have faith and trust in God's messages to us so that we can truly be His instruments in the world. Advent is a time to reflect on God's presence and message to us in our lives.

Joseph is reminded of the words of the Prophet Isaiah; "The virgin shall be with child and give birth to a son, and they shall call him Emmanuel." This name means "God is with us." As we enter this final week of Advent, let us remember that "God is truly with us" always and this is the reason for the season. We need to remember that God will never abandon us, and He came to set us free and bring us the gift of salvation.
