Pastor's Message

Dear Parishioners,

As we begin this Lenten Season, we hear in today's Gospel from Matthew about how Jesus went into the desert to pray for forty days and was tempted by the devil. We have these forty days of Lent to pray and experience conversion in our lives. Like Jesus, we also may be tempted by the devil.

Lent is a time of prayer, fasting, and alms giving as we strive to purify our lives and become better people. We are given this opportunity each year to reflect on our need for God's mercy and forgiveness as we assess our lives and actions in how we are living out God's call to holiness by following His commandments. In our time of prayer, we may be challenged and tempted by the devil to justify our actions so that we do not recognize the seriousness of our faults. Jesus invites us to be strong in our efforts to stand up to the devil and be drawn closer to His desire for mercy and forgiveness.

As we fast and do acts of penance and charity, we are telling the Lord that we are His and we desire to be Holy. Our acts of sacrifice and giving things up are ways to show the Lord our best intentions to be His people and His witnesses in the world that we live. This season is a time to die to sin and rise to new life in the Lord Jesus and this gift of resurrection has been given to us in our Baptism and will be renewed as we renew our Baptismal Promises on Easter Sunday. This time of reflection calls us to conversion in our lives. As we heard on Ash Wednesday; "Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return," or "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel." These two sayings remind us where we came from and where we are going and call us to experience conversion in our life. The second form invites us to be committed to the Gospel message as we strive to give up sin and be better people.

I pray that we may all have an effective Lenten Season leading us to lives of holiness.



FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT



Lent: A time for healing and renewal

St. Nicholas Parish Lenten Mission March 13 – 16, 2023

Lenten Mission Director: Fr. Jacob Carazo, OFM Conv.



All are invited to reflect on how to live a healthy and holy Lent that will lead us to healing and renewal. We are all aware of the penitential acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Now, we can together explore over four days, how to strengthen those penitential acts as we continue listening to the challenging call to conversion, purification, and enlightenment.

Father Jacob will begin guiding us to our Lenten Mission preaching at the Sunday Masses the weekend of March 11 - 12, 2023, as well as at Daily Mass during the Lenten Mission. The talks will take place Monday, March 13 - Wednesday, March 16 from 9:45 - 10:45 AM followed by a 30-minute time for questions and answers. The same talks will take place in the evening from 7 - 8 PM followed by a 30-minute time for questions and answers. On Thursday, March 16, the focus will be on Penance and Reconciliation and the talks will be from 9:45 - 10:15 AM followed by confessions and then in the evening from 7 - 7:30 PM with confessions to follow.

The morning and evenings talks will be in the Parish Hall Monday, March 13 – Wednesday, March 16, while the Thursday, March 17 final talks on Penance and Reconciliation in the morning and evening will be in the church.

Pastoral Service Appeal 2023

Lenten Penitential Practices

Please remember that all Catholics in the U.S. are encouraged to enter into sacrificial penance, during the 40 days of Lent.

Abstinence: Catholics aged 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

Fasting: In the dioceses in the United States, Catholics aged 18 through 59 are bound to fast on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (April 7, 2023.

Easter Duty: All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept is to be fulfilled during the Easter Season unless it is fulfilled, for a just cause, at some other time during the year. This period is extended to include all the weeks of Lent and the Easter Season up to Pentecost Sunday, May 28, 2023
