**Message from our Parochial Administrator**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This week I just want to update you on a few important things that are going on in our Parish. First, I would like to inform you that since our music director, Mr. Emmett Loera, decided to retire on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, we have been vigorously searching for a new music director. I am happy to announce we have found a great music director. His name is Dr. Nové Deypalan. He will begin his new post at St. Nicholas on August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023. We hope Dr. Nové will strengthen our music ministry at St. Nicholas with many concerts to come along with a children's choir. We look forward to welcoming him to our St. Nicholas family.

Next, I would like to update you on a couple of ongoing projects to best serve our parishioners. It is very inspiring to witness our seniors with walkers and wheel chairs coming to mass by bus on Sunday. This is why we would like to start these projects to accommodate them, the least we could do is to help make our seniors more at ease as they come to worship at St. Nicholas. One is the automatic push-button for the doors on the big parking lot side and the small parking lot side. We have agreed with a vendor to install those automatic push-button doors in the next few weeks. Our plant manager is working hard on it. The second ongoing project is the overhead cover on the big parking lot entrance into the church. We hope to get the permit from the city in the next couple weeks to start the installation. The overhead cover will help give shade to our seniors after Mass while waiting for the bus in the scorching sun or when it's raining. Also, we plan to place a welcoming table for new parishioners under this overhead cover.

In this Sunday's gospel reading, the Canaanite woman was persistent in her request with our Lord to heal her daughter, a lesson of persistence in our prayer. I believe that if we are persistent in our prayer and our faith, together we will build a great community of faith and love here at St. Nicholas. May the Lord continue to watch over each one of you and your love ones.

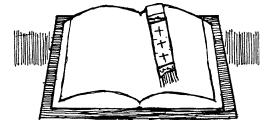

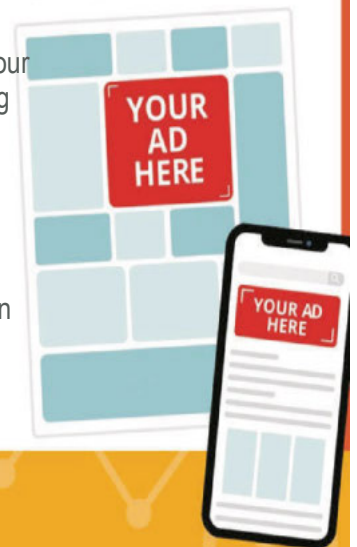
