#### Message from our Parochial Vicar

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

According to the Liturgical calendar, May and October are the two months that we are called to dedicate our life to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We have so many ways to do this, but saying the rosary is a way that all of us share in common. In Vietnamese Catholic culture, children and even adults often have a liturgical dance in front of a Blessed Virgin Mary statue before Mass or during prayer for the whole month of May. In October, they say the rosary for the whole month. I remember when I was 8 to 11 years old, I was chosen with eleven other kids to dance every day in front of Blessed Virgin May statue before Prayer of Community for the whole month. I and other kids went to the rice field to collect different kinds of wild flowers to offer Mary because each one of us represented one color of flower. I loved to dance because I would get free candies and food after I finished. However, as a kid, I did not like to say the rosary on October. I did not understand the meaning and value of the rosary. There was no free food and I thought that saying the rosary was for seniors, not kids. October became a burden for me when I was a kid. I had to pray and say rosary with my parents in the early morning at home from 4:30 AM - 5:00 AM, with the whole community at church from 7:00 PM to 8:00 PM, and again with my parents at home before I went to bed from 8:30 PM - 9:00 PM.

I now love to the recite rosary because I understand the meaning, values and beauty of it. When we say the rosary, we together with Mary immerse ourselves in the mission and person of Jesus Christ. The Blessed Virgin Mary also asked us to recite the rosary for the conversion of sinners. We can see by regulary prayinh the rosary, we understand God's will in our life.

Recognizing the will of God is also the message we reflect upon in this weekend's readings. We always have to make a decision for ourselves. We sometimes change our decision because we later know the good and the bad for us or for others. But God's will cannot be changed because the will of God itself is grace and goodness for us. Jesus says that "for this is the will of my Father, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in him may have eternal life, and shall raise him on the last day" (John 5, 40).

How do we put our faith into action and understand the will of God in our life? First, we need to put away our thinking "my way is everything". In the first reading, we come to know that God's way and thought is not our way and thought. The Lord always shows his mercy and compassion to the sinners who change their sinful way of life and return to God. God knows what is good for us and others. Second, it is our openness to others. Saint Paul reminds us in the second reading that we shall receive others in the same way we receive Jesus Christ. Finally, we shall willingly change ourselves for the greater good. The second son in today's Gospel changes his mind to fulfill his father's will. The action of the second son represents sinners who change their lives and return to God for the salvation of their souls.

Let us continue to recite the rosary and live the will of God the Father in the way that Blessed Virgin Mary requested us to do, especially during this October: penance, prayer and devotion to her Immaculate heart. May Mary Mother of God continue to intercede for us that we always live in the grace and mercy of God. Amen.






