- ♦ Why should you receive the Sacrament? The Anointing of the Sick conveys several graces and imparts gifts of strengthening in the Holy Spirit against anxiety, discouragement, and temptation, and conveys peace and fortitude. These graces flow from the atoning death of Jesus Christ, for "this was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, 'He took away our infirmities and bore our diseases.' (Matt. 8:17)
- ♦ Who may receive the Sacrament? Those who are:
 -suffering from chronic or acute illnesses
 -preparing for hospitalization or surgery.
 -preparing for a medical procedure or treatment.
 - ...experiencing mental or emotional stress with physical symptoms.
 - ...living with recurring illnesses or disabilities.
 - ...living with a terminal illness or in hospice care.
 - ...those of mature age or in frail health.
