

Because I was called to join God's missionary work, I felt able to share God's love with the children. Therefore, I hope that we continue to pray and to support the parents in their responsibility as the primary religious educators of their children. Through growth in their faith, the children can be witnesses of love to people whom they encounter or interact with in their lives.

Do you wear a hearing aid or but have trouble hearing every word in the church?

St. Nicholas Parish has installed a HEARING LOOP in the church for those of you that wear a hearing aid but still have trouble hearing every word. A HEARING LOOP is a special type of sound system for use by people with hearing aids. It sends clear pure sound to your hearing aid or CI (cochlear implant) without background noise.

If you are wearing a hearing aid, please set it to the "T-COIL" SETTING. If you do not know if you have a T-Coil, please take the card, available in the church pews, to your audiologist.

If you do not wear a hearing aid and would like to listen in the loop, please go to the sacristy at least 15 minutes prior to the beginning of Mass to check out a listening device.






