

PASTORAL LETTER: FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

This weekend the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord, which occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus. It is hard to believe that forty days have passed since Christmas! But it is important to mark this event for two reasons: first, to show the historical reality of the man Jesus, and second, to emphasize the "Jewishness" of Jesus.

Many people, then and now, have denied or downplayed the mystery that the Son of God actually came to earth as a human being and lived among us in every way except sin. This doctrine of the Incarnation is of the essence of our faith. We believe that Christ came on earth, died and rose for us, so that we might rise with him one day.

For this reason, then, we Christians believe that Jesus was born into a particular family and a particular culture. He was fully Jewish, and his parents raised him in the practice of the Jewish faith. The first-born son of every Jewish family was "presented" to the Lord on the fortieth day of his birth, to thank God for him and to offer him to God. This is another way that we acknowledge the historical fact of the birth of Christ.

It is a sad fact of our Christian history that this Jewishness of Jesus has been neglected, and that so much antisemitism has been the result. Christians and others have persecuted Jews in virtually every generation, including our own. This Sunday might be a good opportunity for us to re-examine our own complicity in this evil, and to redouble our efforts at reconciliation.

Pope John Paul II often referred to the Jewish people as "our elder brothers and sisters," and today would be a good day to re-emphasize this connection. At the first Presentation of the Lord, Jesus was given to the world as a Jewish child, who would one day become our Messiah and Lord.


