

**FATHER JOHN'S CORNER:**



### THEOPHANIES

Today's readings recount three theophanies, or particular manifestations of God's presence. The prophet Isaiah is caught up in a dramatic scene of heavenly worship, with a royal throne, burning embers, and seraphim singing, "Holy, holy, holy." Isaiah is overwhelmed. In the responsorial psalm, the assembly adds its own worship to that of the seraphim: "In the sight of the angels, I will sing your praises, Lord" (Psalm 138:1).

Paul reminds the Corinthians of his own experience of a post-Resurrection appearance of the Lord, making him an apostle, but one "born abnormally" (1 Corinthians 15:8), since he had no acquaintance with the earthly Jesus. The first of those who did know the earthly Jesus were surprised by fishing advice from the teacher who had commandeered Simon's boat, resulting in an extraordinary catch. Although less colorful than those of Isaiah or Paul, this theophany was just as overwhelming.

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The song of the angels, "Holy, Holy, Holy," resounds from our lips at every Mass. There was a widespread belief in the first religions of the world that God stirred creation into being by a word, a song, a musical note. Music and a sense of God's presence have always been inseparable. In the liturgy, your voice is invited into this song as the priest names the reasons for our praise. "Heaven and earth are full of your glory," and we are not passive onlookers, but participants in this glory. Catholic prayer no longer assigns this angelic hymn to a choir, but gives it to you to sing. Even if your voice is thought to be suitable only for a well-insulated shower stall, you are called into this song.

We are born to sing—just listen to a baby testing the full range of newly-discovered vocal abilities. Soon we get shushed and hushed into quiet, and given lots of messages that our voices are unwanted, and that we need to raise our hands in order to be heard. All of that is overturned in liturgy, the place where God waits to hear us come alive in the song of all creation. In heaven, everyone's in the choir; why not start practicing now?

### LOOKING TO THE FUTURE:

As we move forward in looking at the options and feasibility of constructing the building of the second phase of the parish development we hired Changing Our World, a fundraising consulting firm to survey the parish. Changing our World conducted 11 interviews with parish leaders, influencers, and donors to gain their insights about the proposed parish projects and to determine their support for a potential combined campaign.

At the same time this past October, parishioners were encouraged to participate in an online study survey that was prepared by Changing Our World and distributed through email. A total of 124 survey responses have been evaluated.

Changing Our World then prepared a final report of their findings based on the interviews and study surveys of:

- ♦ 12.5% (135/1083) of registered parishioners.
- ♦ 63% (135/214) were regular financial contributors to the parish.

### RESULTS:

**Q:** Is the parish doing a good job of serving the needs of its parishioners?


**A:** 125 (94.7%) said Yes; 7 (5.3%) were Unsure

**Q:** What factors could impact your level of financial support to a capital campaign?

**A:** The most common response theme was understanding the plan and how the funds would be used.
