

### MISSION STATEMENT



#### **FATHER JOHN'S CORNER:**

On July 1<sup>st</sup> I marked 20 years as pastor here in Grafton. First as pastor of Immaculate Conception and Assumption churches and then as pastor of Our Lady Queen of Peace. So much has happened both personally as well as ministerially during those years. I buried two brothers and my mom with my dad dying two weeks after my mom. During these 20 years the parishes merged to form Our Lady Queen of Peace and a new church building was built. Various ministries have come and gone as well as people entering and leaving my life. It would be something to count the number of baptisms, weddings, funerals and all the other sacraments that have been celebrated over these years.

I could never have done the things that I did or made it through the things that have happened to me without your support and prayers. This is a great community, and it has only been through your empowering me to stretch myself that I have been able to respond to God's call. I sit back and am amazed of what God has done here in Grafton and how he has used me as his instrument to do it. Thank you for your confidence in me to achieve God's plan for us.

Of course, 20 years is a long time and I have been asked over and over what my intentions moving forward will be. I even had my doctor ask if I wasn't retiring soon! Retirement is not possible for another 12 years if then. And I have no plans to move to another parish at this time. However, I also am not in charge. Until God or the Bishop tell me otherwise, I plan on continuing to stay where I am. There are still many things that I want to accomplish. The construction of the office and parish center buildings being a big one. I also wish to work to strengthen the current ministries as well as add new ones to meet the needs of the parish. There is still much that is needed in the area of youth activities, liturgy, adult education and spiritually enhancing prayer experiences such as retreats. The list is very long and with your continued support, prayer and participation I hope to seek to continue to strengthen the community where we worship our God and serve our neighbor.

The parish festival is drawing closer. Please keep **Saturday August 5** open and invite family and friends to spend an evening of prayer, food and fun. <u>4:30pm Mass will be outdoors on that day</u> followed by entertainment, food and games. It has been a great time to get together and meet new friends and renew friendships. This year will be even better. I am looking forward to spending the evening with all of you.
