## SUNDAY MASS READINGS

### *Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe*

#### First Reading (Daniel 7:13-14)

As the visions during the night continued, I saw one like a Son of man coming on the clouds of Heaven; when he reached the Ancient One and was presented before him, the one like a Son of man received dominion, glory and kingship; all peoples, nations and languages serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not be taken away, his kingship shall not be destroyed.

#### Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 93:1-2, 5)

**The Lord is king; he is robed in majesty.**

#### Second Reading (Revelation 1:5-8)

Jesus Christ is the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead and ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood, who has made us into a kingdom, priests for His God and Father, to Him be glory and power forever and ever. Amen.

Behold, He is coming amid the clouds, and every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him. All the peoples of the earth will lament Him. Yes. Amen.

"I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "the One who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

#### Gospel (John 18:33b-37)

Pilate said to Jesus, "Are you the king of the Jews?" Jesus answered, "Do you say this on your own or have others told you about me?" Pilate answered, "I am not a Jew, am I? Your own nation and the chief priests handed You over to me. What have You done?" Jesus answered, "My kingdom does not belong to this world. If My kingdom did belong to this world, My attendants would be fighting to keep Me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, My kingdom is not here." So Pilate said to Him, "Then you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to My voice."

## **PROPERTY TAX REBATE IS EXTENDED**

The Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program has been extended and applications are now available. The guidelines permit individuals that qualify to received a rebate between \$250 and \$650 for property taxes or rent paid last year. The application must be filed by December 31, 2021.

To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years or older. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$35,000 or less and renters with annual incomes of \$15,000 or less could qualify. Only half of your annual Social Security or SSI Income is counted toward the income guideline. For more information or an application, call United POLAM Social Services Monday through Friday between 10 AM and 4 PM at 215-923-1900, and a staff member will assist you.
