2022 CARNIVAL UPDATES

After talking with Skelly's, our Carnival vendor, the decision was mutually made to cancel our May 2022 Carnival.

The main issue was the fact that while we were told by the Philadelphia Health Department that we can apply for a permit, but absolutely no guarantee could be given that it would actually be granted. Too many factors, known and unknown, were involved.

As discussed last year, buying food and other perishables and ordering all that's needed for a successful Carnival would turn into big losses if the city turned us down.

Social distancing, masks, crowd control, even more Corona "spikes" which have obviously happened and could happen again, and other issues too, such as car thefts and even severe violence seeping into the "Far Northeast", made this a clear but still sad decision for Skelly's and us.

Our super Carnival Volunteers learned this decision first. Please join them so that together we can put all our work and all our prayer into having a Carnival in May 2023.
