





in Christ's name. Amen.





NATIONAL VOCATIONS AWARENESS WEEK





National Vocation Awareness Week, celebrated November 1-7, is an annual week-long observance of the Catholic Church in the United States. It is dedicated to foster vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are discerning one of these vocations.

The Diocese of Fort Worth is blessed to have 32 seminarians in various stages of the thorough discernment and formation journey. The Diocese is committed to paying for all of the costs associated with their formation and education so that these men can commit to prayer and formation during their time in seminary, a period which can be between seven and nine years and cost \$50,000 annually. To conclude National Vocations Week, all parishes in the Diocese will take up a special collection next weekend on November 7-8, for the Diocesan Seminarian Education Fund.
