MESSAGE FROM THE DEACON

This week marks the third Sunday of Advent. The Church refers to it as Gaudete or Rejoicing Sunday, because it reminds us that we are preparing for a joyful occasion. Jesus Christ's coming past, present, and future is indeed a joyful and encouraging time in our lives. In the midst of all of the chaos we deal with on a daily basis, today's scripture reminds us that God always has greater plans for us.

John the Baptist is an interesting person for us to pay attention to. As a cousin of Jesus, he was born into a similar line of poverty. As Scripture says, he lived in the wilderness eating locusts and honey and was clothed in camel's hair. Can you imagine if we all had the same zeal to John's message? Can we dare to believe what that would be like!
