Holy Days of Obligation

There have been some questions with regard to the obligations of the 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas Day this year. The Archdiocese has determined that each obligation must be met by attendance at one of the Masses of the Sunday and one of the Holyday. That is, a Christmas Mass on the evening of Sunday 24 December (Vigil or Night) will not satisfy the obligation for 4th Sunday of Advent. There are two distinct obligations: that of 4th Sunday of Advent which can be met by attendance at Masses on Saturday, December 23rd or the morning Masses of Sunday, December 24; and that of Christmas which can be met by attendance at Masses on Christmas Eve (Vigil or Night) and those on Christmas Day. http://www.usccb.org/beliefs-and-teachings/what -we-believe/canon-law/complementary-norms/canon-1246.cfm
