From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Continuing with The Faithful People, found in the Archdiocesan Liturgical Handbook, Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon in section 1.12.1 to 1.12.2, is “Genuflections and bows”:

A genuflection, made by bending the right knee to the ground, signifies adoration, and therefore it is reserved for the Blessed Sacrament, as well as for the Holy Cross from the solemn adoration during the liturgical celebration on Good Friday until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.

During Mass, three genuflections are made by the priest celebrant: namely, after the showing of the host, after the showing of the chalice, and before Holy Communion. Concelebrants bow as the celebrant makes the first two of these genuflections, and genuflect individually as they prepare to communicate.

If, however, the tabernacle with the Blessed Sacrament is present anywhere in the sanctuary, the priest, the deacon, and the other ministers genuflect when they approach the altar and when they depart from it, but not during the celebration of Mass itself. Otherwise all who pass before the Blessed Sacrament genuflect, unless they are moving in procession. Ministers carrying the processional cross or candles bow their heads instead of genuflecting.
