Taxpayer Information

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Continuing with The Faithful People, found in the Archdiocesan Liturgical Handbook, Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon in sections 1.13.1, 1.13.2 and 1.14.1, are “Other Gestures” and “Additional Gestures and Postures”:

During the Penitential Act, if the *Confiteor* is used, the faithful strike their breast three times at the words ‘my fault...my fault....my most grievous fault’.

At the Gospel when the priest or deacon announces the reading it is customary for the faithful to make a sign of the cross on their forehead, lips and breast.

Unless approved for the Universal Church by the Holy See or for the local Church by the competent Bishop’s Conference, other gestures and postures cannot be admitted to the Sacred Liturgy. Liturgical law is prescriptive in nature and therefore the absence of a prohibition does not allow for innovation.
