Taxpayer Information

There is a \$300/\$600 tax-deduction available for charitable contributions for 2021. For those tax payers who take the standard deduction (instead of itemizing), they can receive a \$300 tax deduction (\$600 for married filing jointly) for cash donations to eligible non-profit organizations. (Prior to 2020, there was no donation tax break available for those who took the standard deduction.)
