## Child Protection Requirements for STAFF & VOLUNTEERS

Each year the Archdiocese of Portland has training requirements for keeping our children and youth safe and to educate adults on "red flags" that can put themselves and others at risk. This year's training is "Social Media Safety" through the Praesidium Academy website, which can be found here [https://www.praesidiumacademy.com/learn/sign\\_in?return\\_to=%2Flearn%2F](https://www.praesidiumacademy.com/learn/sign_in?return_to=%2Flearn%2F) or by going to [archdpdx.org](http://archdpdx.org). Once there, find *Child Protection/Victim Assistance* at the top of the page and view information under *Child Protection Training*. Once you sign in to Praesidium, "Social Media Safety" should be at the top. Complete the training and email or bring in a copy to the office.

For **new** volunteers who will be working with minors: the Archdiocese requires an in-person Safe Environment Training (C.A.S.E.). The class is approximately 2 hours and will be offered at St. Frederic on **Sunday, October 23, 2022 at 12:20 p.m.** in St. Joseph Room. # From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

The “Minister of Exposition” of the booklet entitled Information Regarding Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament published by the Archdiocese of Portland states:

An authorized lay minister may open the tabernacle and also, as required, place the ciborium on the altar or place the host in the monstrance. At the end of the period of Adoration, the minister replaces the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle. It is not lawful, however, for an authorized lay minister to give the blessing with the Blessed Sacrament.

A priest or deacon who presides at Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament should vest in an alb, or a surplice over a cassock, and a stole. Other ministers should wear either the liturgical vesture that is used in the region or the vesture that is befitting this ministry and is approved by the Ordinary.

The priest or deacon should wear a white cope and humeral veil to give the blessing at the end of Adoration, when Exposition takes place with the monstrance; in the case of Exposition with the ciborium, he should put on at least the humeral veil.
