Our theme this week is Captured.

Reflection questions:

- Do I really believe that there is an enemy who has plans to ruin my life?
- How do I see Satan differently after hearing the homily today in Mass?
- What lies and accusations has the enemy spoken into my life?
- Why is everything messed up? Remember Original Sin?
- * Pray and ask Jesus to expose the lies, accusations, and divisions that the enemy has used or is using to wreak havoc in my life.
- * Consider capturing those lies and accusations in writing. Ask God for the grace to hear his loving voice, not hateful whispers of the enemy.


