## TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: MATTHEW 15:21-28





Holy Communion and the Human Spirit Link. In a book entitled **Healing Through the Mass** (pages 84-85, published by Resurrection Press and authored by Fr Robert DeGrandis S.S.J.) I read the following. NASA did some experimenting with a special type of camera that could see the energy levels in the human body. This is then seen on a monitor. This energy shows up as an aura around the body. NASA's interest in the experiment was to investigate the effects of space travel on astronauts in orbit. Experimenting in a hospital they discovered that when a person is dying, the aura around the body is thinner and gets thinner and thinner until the person dies. The scientist carrying out this investigation in the hospital and his associate were behind a twoway mirror. They could see with their camera another man coming into the room with light coming from his pocket. Then the man took the object from his pocket and did something so that in the camera the whole room was filled with light and with their camera they could no longer see what was happening. They ran to the room to see what was causing so much light to appear in their camera. They discovered that the dying man was being given Holy Communion. Afterwards with their camera they could see that the aura around him was brighter. Although in his fifties, the scientist conducting the experiment decided to become a Priest after witnessing that. <u>Disaster Relief in Beirut, Lebanon-Emergency Special</u> <u>Collection: August 22-23:</u> The explosion, felt 3+ miles away,



leveled buildings and shattering windows for miles. 5,000 people were injured and at least 137 were killed. Please donate to help those in need! In response to the <u>recent explosion in Beirut, Lebanon</u>, Most Reverend Michael F. Olson has announced an emergency special

collection in the Diocese of Fort Worth on <u>August 22-23, 2020</u>. Funds collected will be directed to Catholic Relief Services (CRS). Hosting more than 1-million Syrian refugees while battling the COVID-19 pandemic, Lebanon is already suffering from an economic and a healthcare crisis. On August 4, a massive explosion rocked the city, injuring more than 5,000 and killing at least 137. Officials are still evacuating residents, while trying to grasp the cost in human life and misery.

Along with Caritas Lebanon, CRS is distributing emergency supplies, clearing rubble and preparing medical and mental health team for dispatch. When you give, you provide critical and immediate relief to the most vulnerable—hot meals, safe shelter, medication, hygiene kits and clean water. Your gift also helps ensure that mobile medical units and trauma support are available for those who need it most. Your prayers and support are urgently needed. Please give generously and donate to help families affected by the explosion in Beirut.

CCHD local grant awarded to Seymour Ministerial Alliance: The Sunday before Thanksgiving is the annual second collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD). 25% of the funds collected stay in the Diocese. These funds are used for local projects/needs that assist needy families. Sacred Heart requested grant assistance for our community and the Diocesan Advancement Foundation just awarded this week a \$5,000 grant to the Seymour Ministerial Alliance (SMA). SMA assists those with paying utility bills, providing gas vouchers or making sure a family has food. This has been especially true since the coronavirus with the SMA helping with debit card food purchases the last few months at our United Supermarket store here in Seymour. Occasionally SMA is asked to assist travelers with over-night lodging. We have been truly blessed!

CONGRATULATIONS AND PRAYERS: Trent Barton has been officially accepted into the Fort Worth Diocesan Seminary Formation Program. He will be assigned to the St. Joseph Seminary College in Covington, LA beginning this fall semester. He will be in discernment and formation for 6-7 years before being ordained.
