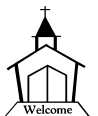

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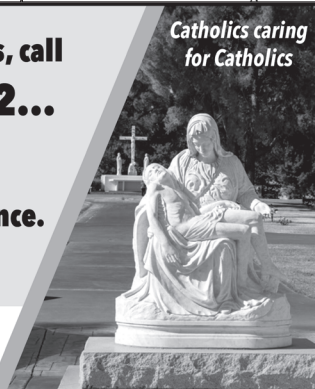
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Mass & Confessions: Mass is held on Sunday at 10:00 a.m. Confessions are heard directly after Mass each Sunday.
