As we reflect on the last fiscal year here at St. Vincent de Paul Church, I am humbled and grateful for our parish community. We have much to be thankful for and much to celebrate. Construction on our new Catholic Education Building is almost complete. We are working on the required final inspections. Our target for occupancy is mid-October.


