Attention Current and Potential St. Joan of Arc Families,

As we begin our registration process for the 2023-2024 school year, we understand that paying tuition requires a substantial sacrifice from each family. Each year, the Archdiocese of Detroit offers Tuition Assistance to any K – 8 family in need. Applications are filled out online through the FACTS program. Please see the link below for the FACTS website. If you have not created an account, you must do so before submitting your application.

The Archdiocese of Detroit has updated its application process. There will now only be ONE deadline date of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023. *It is imperative that you apply by this new deadline if you would like your family considered for the program.* You will be asked to submit financial information. Since March 31<sup>st</sup> is before the deadline for the 2022 tax season, you will only need to submit your 2021 taxes and not your 2022 taxes. However, certain 2022 information may need to be submitted. In addition to the online application, each family will need to complete the *Pastor Signature Form* attached to this document. You may turn this form into the school for Msgr. G. Michael Bugarin review and sign.
